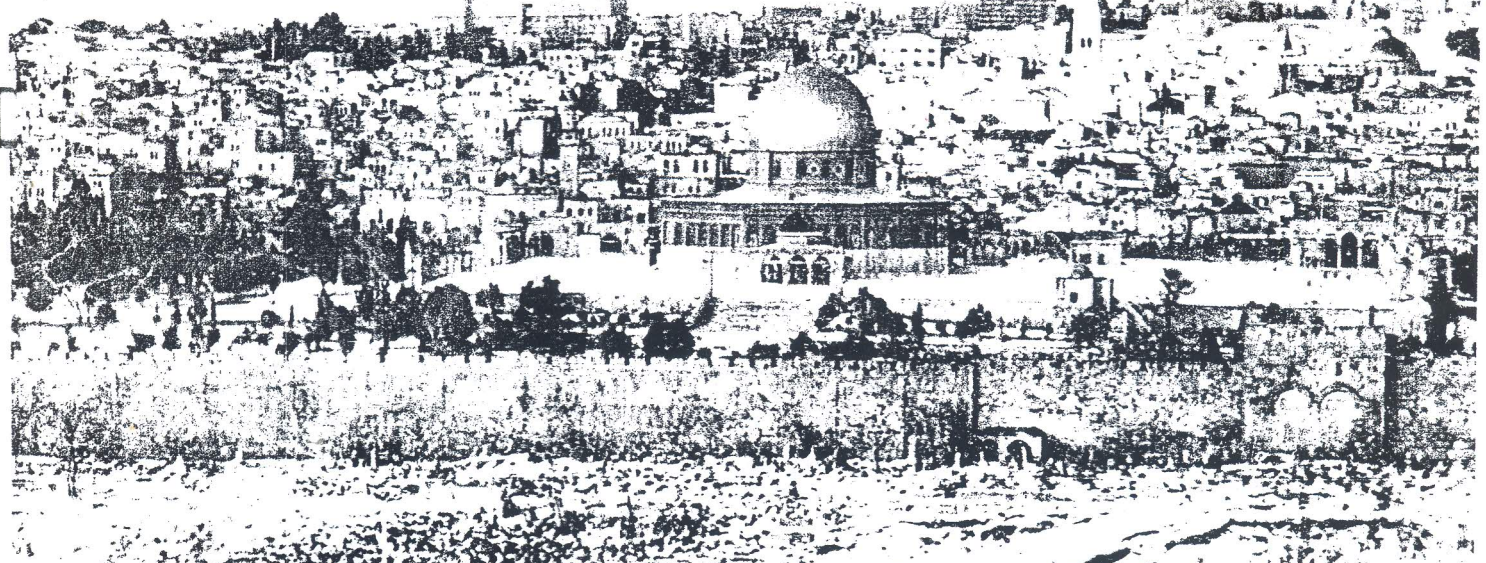

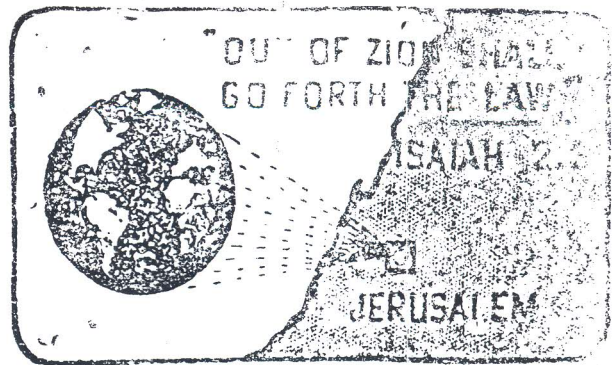

In the foreground you see a portion of the east wall around the Old City, and to your right is the Golden gate, the Eastern gate, through which Yahshua (Jesus) passed riding upon an ass as prophesied by Zechariah chapter 9 verse 9, recorded also in Mathew 21: 4 to 9. Ezekiel said this gate would be closed and never opened, because the Lord passed through it (Ezekiel 44: 1 to 3). Note the Mohammedan cemetery surrounding the gate. THE LAST GENERATION IN BIBLE PROPHECY

pass away till all is fulfilled — Luke 21:24-32

There are many different opinions about the number of years that constitute a generation, and it is always known that a generation is from father to son, but this is far from being definite as to the number of years. It is best to use the scriptures to give this answer.

The Heavenly Father did not intend to leave us in the dark about this important question mentioned particularly by the Saviour concerning His coming and the end of this age.

One religious denomination in particular made a very special message out of this subject, following the great meteoric shower, known as the "falling of the stars" in 1833, and following to 1844, as well as many years afterwards. They had read only the narrative given by Matthew of his great sermon of Christ, and based their argument on the dark day of 1789 and the falling of the stars in 1833, claiming that people living to see those unusual phenomena, would live to see the return of the Saviour, that He would come during that generation.

In-as-much, however, as those people are all dead, who were living in that period, they quite naturally have dropped this subject out of their teaching. They have not yet discovered that other witnesses besides Matthew also told us about this great sermon of the Master.

THE LAST EVENTS ANNOUNCED BY LUKE

Luke brought to us another portion of the discourse, which Matthew left out. It was about the ending of Gentile times — the Jews being dispersed among all nations UNTIL the times of the Gentiles were fulfilled; of the distress of nations; of the great perplexity; of Men's

hearts failing them for fear; and of THE POWERS OF THE HEAVENS BEING SHAKEN, which were the very last events to take place just before He was to appear in the clouds of heaven, returning as He went away. This generation now (seeing these) things is not to pass away till the Messiah returns.

Matthew also mentioned, "The powers of the heavens being shaken as the last event (Matt. 24:29), but the dear people, living in 1844, loved their Saviour and wanted to see Him come in their day, which no doubt caused them to overlook, the great subject of the Jew, of His dispersal among the nations, with His returning to Jerusalem, and Esau the Arabs no longer in possession of the Holy Land, that was to be trodden down by the Gentiles during the period of Gentiles times, when the gospel was to be preached as a witness to all nations before the end.

We are instructed that, "By the mouth of two or three witnesses shall every word be established". — 2 Cor. 13: So many make the mistake in establishing their prophetic, and doctrinal teaching of consulting only one witness and then drawing their conclusion, when if they had more carefully consulted all who had spoken on the subject, would have been revealed to them in a different light.

In order to rightly sum up the last events of this Gentile age before the return of the Master, it is necessary to read the narrative of both Matthew and Luke. Find out what each one says about the events to transpire before "the powers of the Heavens are shaken", by the atom and hydrogen bomb as they are being shaken today. Then we will know what generation it is that, "shall not pass away till ALL be fulfilled".

KIBBUTZ LIFE IN AMERICA

MADISON, Wisconsin (AP). — Twenty-four young people who want to "exist Jewishly" on a traditionally radical campus are experimenting with Israel-style living at the Kibbutz Langdon, nestled away in an old sorority house near the University of Wisconsin.

The kibbutz, formed in 1970, has been ignored by the less religious Jewish students and has been the target of barbs from the more orthodox.

ANTI-JEWISH SERIES IN AUSTRIAN PAPER

LONDON (JTO). — A series of Vienna newspaper articles on "The Jews in Austria" has led to an "ominous resurgence" of anti-Semitism in that country, the London "Financial Times" correspondent reports. The Austrian Press Council has decided to hold an investigation into the series which reportedly set off a spate of anti-Semitic incidents.

LIBYA SAYS IT GAVE ARABS 70 MIGS IN OCTOBER WAR

RABAT (AP). — Libya contributed more than half a billion dollars in aid, including 400 combat missions and 70 new Soviet Mig-21 air-planes, to the Arabs in the October war, a Tripoli newspaper claims.

The newspaper "Al Fatah" — The Conqueror — said official documents backed up its figures, released to "reply to detractors of Libya".

Libya had provided \$542,164,000 in aid before the war broke out on October 6, it said, "without counting the mobilization of all the nation's potential to respond to any request from an Arab frontline nation, ranging from aircraft to bath soap and including heavy equipment".

SOVIET SECT ASKS NIXON TO HELP

MOSCOW (UPI). — Nearly 200 Pentecost sect members, saying they are persecuted for their faith, appealed to President Nixon yesterday to help them win the right to emigrate to the United States.

Two sect members, Grigori Vashenko and Yevgeni Bresenden, made available to Western newsmen an open letter to Nixon signed by 188 members of the Christian Evangelical sect. They said there are about 100,000 Pentecost members in the Soviet Union and many of them would leave if allowed to do so.

The Pentecosts said they are subjected to fines for performing religious services and some members have been imprisoned for terms up to 10 years.

ASHDOD CITRUS SEASON ENDS

ASHDOD. — Some 22 million crates of citrus fruit were exported through Ashdod Port this season, slightly more than last year, despite the war and the manpower and transport shortage. This was announced here yesterday by port spokesman Haim Shushan at the close of the current season.

WORLD GRAIN SUPPLIES NEAR DANGEROUS LOW

UNITED NATIONS, N.Y. (AP). — World grain reserves have dipped to the point where rich and poor

countries alike will depend "on the vagaries of a single year's weather" for adequate supplies, a U.N. group was told Wednesday.

Remaining stocks no longer provide an adequate buffer against crop failure, declared E. M. Ojala, assistant director of the world Food and Agriculture Organization.

He said food supplies for millions during the coming year thus will depend almost entirely on 1973 harvest

SHORTCOMINGS IN HOUSING ARE NOW LIKELY TO GO AWAY

The provision of adequate housing ranks high among our economic priorities. The most telling slogan in demonstrations of discontent is not "work" or "bread", but "flats for young couples". Accordingly, public spending on housing occupies pride of place after defence.

In spite of pressing emergency needs, the authorities envisage a substantial expansion of residential construction in the coming years as a precondition to improve our welfare standards. Even now we are allocating housing 40 per cent of our gross investment, double the annual combined investment in industry, agriculture, and power plants.

A massive residential construction effort, conceivable coupled with improved urban development schemes, will inevitably, therefore, lead to a general demand for better housing, thus increasing the gap between demand and supply.

TWO SOLDIERS KILLED

Two soldiers were killed by artillery fire on Tuesday and five more wounded yesterday as fighting along the northern front continued.

Note: Syria has been daily for 77 days shooting at Israel. She is the one that always starts the shooting. - Editor

AVOCADO, CARROT EXPORTS RISE

TEL AVIV. — Some 10,500 tons of avocados were exported this year, 1,500 tons more than expected. France bought up about 65 per cent of the crop.

Agrexco is now trying to find new markets and increase the export of avocados. According to estimates, the avocado yield in another four years will be about 30,000 tons and 75 per cent of this will be exported.

Simcha Ofer, head of the vegetable department of Agrexco, announced that Israel's carrots have been very well received in Scandinavia this year; they have imported 3,000 tons, compared with 1,200 tons last year.

Note. — "I will multiply the fruit of the tree, and the increase of the field". — Ezek. 36: 30.

Thousands of tons of other fruits and vegetables are being exported from this little nation. — Editor.

FARM OUTPUT UP IN JUDEA, SAMARIA

There has been a 30 per cent increase in farm production in Judea and Samaria in the past three years — from IL. 345 m. in 1971-72 to IL. 450 m. in 1973-74, it was reported by the Director-General of the Agriculture Ministry, Avraham Brum.

Regional agricultural advisers, who had also served under the Jordanian administration, told Mr. Brum that production levels of the Arab farmers would match those of Israelis within a few years. They said this was largely due to increased mechanization and improved irrigation methods.

WHAT ABOUT MISSIONARIES IN ISRAEL

Many of the missionaries in Israel take their stand with the Catholics and Protestants that Jerusalem should be an international city under the United Nations instead of the Capital City of Israel. Some teach contrary to the Jewish religion on the subject of the God-head. The Sabbath and the Law. They use swines flesh for food. Believe in the cross as a sign of true Christianity when instead it is a sign of heathen intolerance used by the Babylonians and Romans to torture their enemies more than a thousand years B.C.

Many teach that they are the true Israelites who should possess this land, and that the people here called Israel are a mongrel race, and not even Jews, also that Jerusalem will be destroyed again.

The government of Israel however regardless of this is tolerant toward all religion, and grants the free exercise thereof the same as in the U.S.A. It is necessary to closely watch missionaries, however, because many spies have been caught here disguising themselves as missionaries. Furthermore at different times certain missionaries have induced Jews to leave the country, providing them with means on the ground of their pretended conversion to the faith of that particular sect. The government naturally is not pleased with this kind of work because much money has been spent to bring these immigrants here, provide homes, and take care of them.

Also some missionaries take children of poor families and put them in Christian missions where they are taught the law was abolished and nailed to the cross.

"The Reporter" and those connected with it are opposed to such work and unscriptural teaching. We teach that Jewish children are far better when left in Jewish schools where the law and true Sabbath is taught, than they are to be placed in mission schools and taught the abolition of the Holy Ten Commandments.

Such teaching is morally degrading, breeding criminals, and filling penitentiaries and insane asylums to overflowing.

"The Reporter" and those connected with it, known over the world as the "Church of God" — 7th day, do not teach subtraction from the Jewish religion, but the addition of just one point, which our ancient Zealots overlooked, that their Messiah was to come as a babe and grow up as a child Isaiah 9: 6, 7, also 7: 14, and 11: 1, 2) and then to be given as an offering for their sins (Isaiah 53), caught up to heaven from where He is soon coming again as their deliverer, and long promised King. To accept Him as their Messiah, and pray to the Father in his name brings into their life the Holy Spirit fulfilling Ezekiel 36: 24 to 27.

PAST CURSES AND FUTURE BLESSINGS FOR ALL PEOPLE

"Zion saith, 'the Lord hath forsaken me, and my Lord hath forgotten me'. Can a woman forget her sucking child, that she should not have compassion on the son of her womb? Yea, they may forget. Yet will I not forget thee". — Isaiah 49: 14-15.

Many texts of scripture could be brought forth to show how the Lord has chosen Mount Zion in Jerusalem for his dwelling place. Therefore we may expect without disappointment that many good things are now in store for her, since we have passed through the period of judgments and curses so numerous declared throughout the scriptures because of sin and wickedness within her borders.

We will notice just a few scriptures as follows: "Thy holy cities are a wilderness, Zion is a wilderness, Jerusalem a desolation". — Isa. 6: 10.

"They build up with blood, and Jerusalem with iniquity... Therefore shall Zion for your sake be ploughed as a field, and Jerusalem shall become heaps, and the mountain of the house, as the high place of the forest". — Micah 3: 11-12.

Then as we continue to read right on it says: "But in the last days it shall come to pass that the mountain (government) of the house of the Lord shall be established in the top of the mountains, and it shall be exalted above the hills, and people shall flow into it".

Here is another very significant, and well known prophecy which is now in its process of fulfillment. The scripture reads: "Thou shalt arise and have mercy upon Zion, for the time to favor her, yea, the set time is come. For thy SERVANTS take pleasure in her stones, and favor the dust thereof. So the heathen (not the Father's children) shall fear the name of the Lord, and all the kings of the earth thy glory.

When the Lord shall build up Zion, He shall appear in His glory. He will regard the prayer of the desolate, and not despise their prayers. This shall be written for the generations to come, and the people that shall be created shall praise the name of the Lord". — Psalms 102: 13 to 18.

Just before the coming of the Lord to judge the world, he gives a definite command to sound the alarm of His pending judgments from Mount Zion. This command is given through the prophet Joel, as follows: "Blow ye the trumpet in Zion, and sound an alarm in my Holy Mountain. Let all the inhabitants of the land tremble, for the day of the Lord cometh, for it is nigh at hand". — Joel 2: 1.

The remnant people are not only commanded to give out the alarm from Mount Zion in Jerusalem, but they are also commanded to call a solemn assembly there. This scripture reads as follows: "Blow the trumpet in Zion, sanctify a fast, call a solemn assembly. Gather the people, sanctify the congregation, assemble the elders, gather the children and those that suck the breasts. Let the bridegroom go forth of his chamber, and the bride out of her closet. Let the priests, the ministers of the Lord weep between the porch and the altar, and let them say spare thy people, O Lord."
