

THE CONTROVERSY OF ZION IS HERE

Here is a message given to the prophet Isaiah nearly three thousand years ago concerning the outcome of the present build up of world armament. It is a message to all the nations of the whole earth and especially to the U.N.

It is the message for our day in Bible prophecy because Jerusalem was to be trodden down by the Gentiles UNTIL the times of the Gentiles be fulfilled." (Luke 21: 24). Other conditions spoken of here by our Messiah fit this age and time most perfectly, and harmonize with all of the prophets. Isaiah reads: "Come near ye NATIONS to hear and hearken, ye people. Let the earth hear and all there is therein; the world and all things that come from it. For the indignation of the Lord is upon all nations and His fury upon all their armies." — Isa. 34: 1,2.

This is the vision seen by Isaiah, a prophet of Israel, and not one of his prophecies has ever failed to come to pass. He addresses this warning to the entire earth and in vision he saw all their armies given to the slaughter, and utterly destroyed. He then concludes with the statement that, "This is the day of the Lord's vengeance, and the YEAR of recompense for the controversy of Zion." — Verse 8.

UNITED NATIONS TAKE WARNING!

The above prophecy applies to our day, and to the world wide controversy over Zion which is far more deeply rooted than most people realize. It stems from the Arab League, as well as from both Moscow and Rome. The psalmist David said: "When the Lord shall build ap

Zion, He shall appear in His glory." — Psalms 102: 16.

The controversy over Zion that results in the destruction of the enemies of Israel could not come until after Zion was built up. It is being rebuilt both temporarily and spiritually, and stands before us as the greatest miracle of our age. Let the reader keep in mind the announcement of our Saviour that "Jerusalem would be trodden down by the Gentiles" with the Jews led away captive into all nations UN-TIL the times of the Gentiles be fulfilled." — Luke 21: 24.

This land has been a desolation, void of rain fall, with the hard bleak soil parched and cracked by the heat of the sun, for nearly two thousand years, but now, "The desert is blossoming as the rose, and the land resembles the garden of Eden. The controversy over Zion has become a world problem with Jerusalem a burdensome stone and a cup of trembling to all nations. — Zech. 12: 1 to 3.

"It shall come to pass in the LAST DAYS, that the mountain (Government), of the Lord's House shall be established in the top of the mountains, and shall be exalted above the hills, and all nations shall flow into it. And many people will go and say, "come ye, and let us go up to the Mountain of the Lord, to the house of the God of Jacob, and He will teach us of his ways, for out of Zion shall go forth the law, and the Word of the Lord from JERU-SALEM." — Isaiah 2: 2, 3.

The above verses are for the LAST DAYS which never refers to events of the Millennium. Verse 4 is the beginning of the millennium.

By comparing Isaiah 61: 2 with Luke 4: 18, 19 where the Saviour quotes it from Isaiah, we see how He applies the first part of this verse to events of his time, while the last part reaches down two thousand years in the future.

These two verses of Isaiah, however, follow each other in closely connected events. Verse 4 does not apply to the last days, but to the time after the return of the Messiah, which cannot be referred to as THE LAST DAYS OF THIS AGE.

Verses 2 and 3 definitely apply to our period of the "Last Days", and are now beginning to be fulfilled. Hundreds of thousands of spiritually minded people are coming to Jerusalem to view these sacred sites, and come in contact with the Holy Places. Also many are deeply interested in the Word of the Lord, as it is going out from Jerusalem Many are also

sending in their names for our publications papers, books and tracts. This is indeed a wonderful time to live and to have a part in this work.

NEW TOURISM RECORD ESTABLISHED IN MARCH

Tourism records continued to be set in March this year, when 77,500 tourists entered the country, representing a 57 per cent increase over the same month last year. Some 20 per cent of the increase can be attributed to the fact that Pessah and Easter fell during March, the Central Bureau of Statistics reports.

In the first quarter of the year 151,700 tourists arrived, some 52 per cent up on last year's figure for the same period.

A THREAT AND ATTEMPT TO DESTROY US

REVERSED INTO A BLESSING

During the last days of March we received an anonymous letter at the Publishing House threatening to burn us out if we did not cease publishing and distributing tracts, etc. Knowing we had through our prayers here, and that of our many readers, protection from above, the letter was not given to our policemen. About a week later, however, one afternoon we were invaded by a group of around twenty five youths of what is known as the "Jewish Defense League". They swarned into all rooms, including our upstairs living rooms.

We never called the police, but within minutes, perhaps three or four minutes, a car load of police arrived. Seeing the situation they must have called more through their "talkie radic car phone". More began coming from all directions. I mentioned it afterwards saying there were twenty or thirty police who came. One man standing near, said: "there were at least fifty

here".

Some struck the police, but they soon cleared them out arresting some as trespassers and

taking them away in their cars.

We do not know what they intended to do whether to set fire to our stocks of paper, books and tracts or break up our machinery, but we are very thankful to our heavenly Father above for sending us protection just on time. Praise His Name.

We are also thankful to these policemen for their able way of handling the situation and

friendly attitude toward our work.

During the past month we have sent workers out by car to far distant points like Eilat to the south, with hundreds of Bibles and Testaments as well as around a hundred thousand or more tracts on "Has Our Messiah Come?" and "Twenty Six Messiahs Bring Confusion to Israel", all in the Hebrew language. This is what stirred up the enemy to stop us again. This time by force instead of by law.

On Television

During the disturbance, one of the head men of the Television appeared and wanted to take pictures of the place. He phoned for his men to come with the camera, etc. and they soon arrived but the police and others had left. Later they took pictures of Effie and myself. Also of Andy and other workers, and the different rooms. He asked many questions: why we came here and the nature of our works, and if our belief is different from the Jews.

We explained that our religion was the same as the Jews only we believe in the New Testament and the Old and were trying to get the Jews to read both. THE DISCOVERY OF NOAH'S ARK A SOLEMN WARNING TO THIS UNGODLY WORLD

Several years ago the French Explorer, Fernand Navarra, his son Fernand Jr. and other members of an expedition party, made the discovery of tooled wood embedded in a glacial lake in Turkey. Navarra is convinced that the wood is from remains of the Ark built by Noah to survive the Biblical flood.

Ralph Lenton was a member of the exploratory expedition, made in 1969, to confirm the find. He states that the wood was chopped from stagnant ice covering a small lake high on Mount Ararat, in Turkey, below the 14,000

foot level.

Hugo A. C. Neuburg, field physicist and glaciologist with a background in world-wide geophysical work including two years in Antarctica during the International Geophysical Year, confirms Lenton's observations.

"The discovery of ancient wood at this altitude justifies hard-nosed scientific inquiry," he said. Neuberg and Lendon emphasized that identification of the artifact cannot be made

until "whatever is there is uncovered".

The Arctic Institute of North America, with headquarters in Washington, D.C., prepared plans for engineering operations designed to free the wood from approximately 900,000 cubic meters of ice and rock. The expedition required two summers' work at a cost of about 41 million. Helicopters and sophisticated equipment was provided to be used in the attempt. Ralph Lenton was to direct scientific operations this past summer. Camp facilities for 25 men was made ready and planned for night on the mountains.

Inquiries from all parts of the world indi-

cated widespread interest in this project.

This great expedition for the final uncovering of Noah's Ark was stopped in Turkey, and not permitted to go to Mount Ararat.

It is reported that this was through the in-

fluence of Communism officials.


Nevertheless, the work of uncovering portions of the Ark, and photographing it, has fully established the fact that it is there, and has been miraculously preserved frozen in that lake, and discovered for this very time, as a stern rebuke to all infidels, and anti-God Communists whoever they are. HISTORY AND ORIGIN OF THE CHURCH OF GOD SEVENTH

ENCYCLOPEDIA BRITANNICA LIBRARY RESEARCH SERVICE

"The Church of God (Seventh Day) was organized in separate church organizations in this country soon after the landing of the Pilgrims who came here from London, England, in 1642, at which time there were known to

be seven local churches in London.

"In the year 1664 Stephen Mumford settled at Newport, R. I., having come here from England. In 1671 a church was organized there with William Hiscox chosen and ordained the Elder. He served as pastor of the church until his death (1704) when William Gibson became pastor, serving till 1717. He was in turn succeeded by Joseph Grandall who held the pastorate until 1737. He was succeeded by Joseph Mazen and was followed by William Bliss, who remained pastor until his death in

"During this same period there were churches of God established at the following cities in Pennsylvania: Newton, Pennepeck, Jotting-ham, and French Creek. These churches fraternized with the Churches of God in Rhode Island, and others in New Jersey. Some of the New Jersey Churches were at Piscataway and Cohansey. These are the oldest Sabbatarian churches in America. The church history of New England, 1783 to 1796, chapter 11, section 10, mentions Stephen Mumford and his faith in connection with the Ten Commandments being the Christian standard of a sinless life and of keeping Saturday instead of

"The oldest Sabbatarian Christian Church in America was connected with the oldest in London - the Mill Yard Church - and on the old church records of this church is found a copy of a letter dated December 21, 1680 addressed to the church in Newport, R.I. which proves their connection. There is much other evidence in the records of both churches, besides, which is set forth verbatim on page 271 of the "History of the True Church" by Dug-

ger and Dodd.

"In the year 1705 a church was organized at Pitscataway, N.J. and according to a letter from Samuel Hubbard, one of the charter members of the Newport, Rhode Island church, there was another organized that year at Noodles Island, now East Boston, Massachusetts.

Thomas Ward, a prominent lawyer of Newport, R.I. in 1689 was an outstanding member of the Rhode Island church, Richard Ward, Governor of Rhode Island, 1741-42, was a member of the church also Col. Jobe Bennett in 1763 was the treasurer of this church and that year served on a committee in drafting the constitution for the Brownsville University.

"One of the outstanding Churches of God in the early days of American History was the church of Shrewsbury, N.J. Elder Davis was

pastor of that church early in the seventeenth century and other churches in New Jersey were organized as this church branched out, for instance, the church at Piscataway was organized in 1705 and at Hopewell at about the same time. The records of this church are still to be found, and in Randolph's History of the Seventh Day Baptists it is also mentioned as one of the early sabbatarian churches, of this country. It was the Shrewsbury, N.J. church which went westward and settled in Salem West Va. at this time there were churches organized at Lost Creek, W. Va. and at South Fork of Hughes River, W. Va.

"Between the years 1845 and 1860 State

Conferences were formed and started function ing in Missouri, Iowa, Wisconsin, Minnesota Illinois, Ohio, Michigan, New York, Vermont Massachusetts, Connecticut, and other states Two gospel tents were paid for and operated in the State Conferences during the Summer

"In the year (1861), a general conference con vened at Battle Creek, Mich., and voted to change the name, adopting the name Seventl Day Adventist, for various reasons set fortly Mrs. E. G. White, a supposed prophetes of the denomination. Because of undaunte faith in the leadership of their prophetess o the denomination, leaders recommended th change in all parts of the country and th great majority of the ministers followed th decision of the church, but there was a rem nant who (refused) to sanction this name, i place of the scriptural name, "Church of God mentioned just 12 times in the New Testa ment. Consequently, they called an assembl at Battle Creek, Mich. the following year an launched a paper called the "Remnant of I rael", printed monthly. This was later change to a weekly and the name changed to the "Sal bath Advocate then to the Bible Advocate since being printed at Stanberry, Mo.

"The Reorganization"

"In the fall a general meeting was called many ministers and leaders of the church consider reorganization of the body patter ing it more in accordance with the Bible org nization. The meeting was called to conver at Salem, W. Va. on November 4, 1933. Mi isters and local elders of the congregations many parts of the world were invited to atter or submit names of ministers favouring t reorganization policy, and consequently the were 145 names submitted together with t company assembled. These names were us in choosing officers, respectively for the dif rent offices according to the scriptural org nization. There were 12 men chosen as spiriti leaders, known as the apostles (1 Cor. 1

THE CASE AGAINST SUGAR By Dr. Philip Lovell

You be the Judge!

The per capita consumption of sugar in America has increased many fold during this present generation. Whether or not this change in our daily dietary has been good for us is up to the individual to decide.

There are certain facts which ought to be examined in the process of coming to such a decision. This sets forth a few of them for

your consideration.

Dr. Philip M. Lovell, in the "Los Angeles Times", has this to say about the methods employed in producing the article we know as

sugar":

"In this column the statement has often been made that sugar is a starvation food. Its physiological effect on the body has been demonstrated again and again. In this issue I propose to show how, in the technical manufacture of sugar, it becomes devitalized, demineralized, and robbed of any life giving qualities it once possessed.

"Commercial sugar, as you know, is made from cane sugar and sugar beets. At the present time beet sugar is very much more extensively used than cane sugar. Hence the manufacture of beet sugar will be discussed.

"When the beets are received at the sugar factory, the tops and small part of the neck of the beet are removed. The purpose is to free the beet from mineral matter it contains, as it interfers with the sugar crystallization. Therefore the first robbery of the precious salts is accomplished before the beet undergoes any chemical changes.

The beets are then washed. The juice is extracted by what is known as the diffusion method. This consists of cutting the beet in very thin slices and running a stream of water through them. The sugar is dissolved and passes through the water. When this juice emerges from the beet it is as black as ink. Now comes

the first of the devitalizing processes.

"Lime or carbon dioxide is added to it to precipitate some of the impurities found in this inky black beet sugar. The clear juice remains and is then centrifuged; that is, it is whirled until it separates into two parts - molasses and raw beet sugar.'

"The raw beet sugar is then throughly heated destroying every particle of organized life-celled substance in it. But even now it must be still further chemically treated. It is still not suffi-

ciently white and ghastly.' There are now added strong minerals such as acid calcium phosphate, phosphoric acid, and

milk of lime.'

Then to carry away any suspended protein matter which may remain, the sugar manufac-11 1 Illimin from claughter houses

chase from the slaughter houses-bone black from the "canning" or low grade animals. This bone-black or animal charcoal is used as a filter to "purify" this mixture called sugar.

"Thus far the sugar has been throughly heated twice. Now it must be throughly boiled to separate it from the syrup. You may think that it ought to be ready for consumption now but - not yet."

"The last touch of shining whiteness must

be added.

'It is then bleached with a strong bleaching agent such as blue water. This process holds true with first-grade sugar but it becomes even worse with low-grade sugars. These inferior sugars are extracted from molasses by-products by the action of strong chemicals such as calcium and barium hydroxide. The molasses itself is used in making gelatin and jams and in baking products.

Commercial sugar is representative of the ultimate extreme in food degeneration. Merely to state that it is a starvation food is putting it mildly. The term food is a misnomer. Sugar is the most injurious product in our national dietary with no exception and under every pos-

sible condition."

"The fore-going facts assume special significance when it is pointed out that perhaps sixtyfive per cent of the animals slaughtered for the markets are swine. Therefore the slaughterhouse products mentioned in Dr. Lovell's article must be considered as pork derivaties in that proportion.'

The Pan American Diet Book, by G.W. Remsburg, has the following statements in the chapter

on sugars:

'Granulated or white sugar is deficient in organic salts because of the process of refining, and when taken into the body breaks down the cells in order to furnish the blood with the necessary alkaline elements to neutralize the carbonic acid which is formed by the oxidation of the carbon of which the sugar is composed. Sugar is almost pure carbon.

Fruit sugars are found in all fruits and are really the only ones that the body can digest and assimilate. While they are not quite so sweet, they are quickly and easily digested and pass directly into the circulation. Really no other sugar is needed by the body. In case one does not eat a sufficient amount of fruit sugars, nature can manufacture her own grape sugar from the starches eaten.

Sun dried fruits such as raisins contain a large amount of grape sugar, because by the process of drying, the carbohydrates are changed by the action of the sun into grape sugar. In the best grade of raisins, we find as high as sixty per cent grape sugar."

OUESTION:

Please explain Luke 23: 56. Was this the 7th day Sabbath or the Passover Sabbath?

In Luke 23: 56 they rested on the 7th day Sabbath. The crucifixion being on Wednesday, the next day was the yearly big Sabbath, as introduced in Lev. 23rd. chapter that was always on the 15th of Abib, the day after the Passover. John 19: 313 says it was a High Day Sabbath that followed the crucifixion. The holy women could not prepare their 40 pounds of spices, and other things for anointing his body that day for he was put in the tomb just before the sun set, before the yearly Sabbath. (Matt. 27: 62-66). The women therefore kept the yearly high day Sabbath and prepared the spices on Friday. Then they rested on the Sabbath, according to the commandment. (Luke-23. Note also Mark 16: 1, that they prepared these spices when the Sabbath was past). That is of course the High Day Sabbath, and perfectly harmonizes with the above.

The crucifixion took place on Wednesday, for the 14th of Abib fell on Wednesday the year of the Crucifixion, as astronomers who have been consulted in England, Australia and the U.S. have agreed. Our Messiah was to be in the earth three days and three nights. The was the only sign given to prove that He was

the real Messiah. (Matt. 12: 40).

The resurrection occurred just three days and three nights after he was placed in the tomb, and in the end of the Sabbath, not Sunday morning, as is falsely taught. We have many translations now days by false prophets, of whom the Messiah said there would be many in this closing time who put the resurrection on Sunday. These translations are made by some leading man of some church, who puts himself up above the fifty leading educators selected by King James of England when our King James Bible was translated from the Greek text to the English.

Most of these men only have a very little knowledge of the Greek. Their motive in making a one man translation is to change the texts of scripture they do not like, to suit their own fancy. Had they sat as one of the fifty under King James, they would have lost their head, as that was the agreed penalty for such offenses. Translation had to be strictly according to the

true grammar of the languages used.

QUESTION:

How old is the world?

There is considerable difference of belief regarding the age of the world. What we call Ushers Chronology, places its age since Adam as a little over 5970 years. The Jewish calendar &

places it at 5728 years, but it is a proven fact that neither one is correct for they are based on

much guess work and uncertainty.

Over fifty years ago, I was led to make a careful search of this subject based entirely on the scriptures. I read the entire Old Testament, and with my pencil and paper made a careful record beginning with Adam where it tells us he was a hundred and thirty years old when Seth was born. - Genesis 5: 3.

From there I put down the ages of Seth when his first son was born etc. down to the sojourn in Egypt. Then from their coming out of Egypt you follow the length of time each one of the Judges Kings reigned. I followed first the judah line of kings and upon finding one missing link as to the number of years one king reigned, I went back to the Israel line, but had the same difficulty. Therefore it is not possible to get the time correct. This king may have ruled ten

years, twenty years, or even thirty.

From the Kings you get a connection to the prophecy of Daniel in chapter nine of the 490 years to the time of Christ, from when the commandment went forth to build Jerusalem, after its destruction by king Nebuchadnezzar of Babylon, which was the year 457 B.C. This prophecy takes us with certainty over this period to the events surrounding His coming. History also verifies this, that it was actually 490 years from Ezra, and Artaxeres to Christ. We therefore have absolute proof that we are very near the end of the 6000 years since Adam, and it is evident that the beginning of the 7th thousand year period will be the Restitution age, the 100 years of peace. — Rev. 20, also Acts A: 1 to 21.

The reason why the age of the world as set forth by the Jews today is so far from that given by "Usher", in his Chronology, is that long ago the radical Orthodox who were having great difficulty over the prophecy of Daniel, chapter 9, in the early days of this present age, when so many were following their Messiah, made the claim that there had not been 490 years since the Commandment went forth to build Jerusalem to the birth of the Messiah in Bethlehem, and events pertaining to His ministry. The Jews have ever since held to these erroneous claims. Excavations and different discoveries since that time however have fully established the fact that 490 years did cover this period with accuracy, from the 7th chapter of Ezra to the coming and death of the Mes-

'It was unanimously voted at this gathering to move our world headquarters to Jerusalem, Palestine, and all foreign fields to consider this the world headquarters as a work had previous-

ly been started in Jerusalem.

"This twelve had the oversight over the body of believers as a whole: the Seventy gave themselves to the evangelistic ministry of the Word; the Seven had general oversight and management of the business of the church; the Elders give themselves to the ministry of the Word and to prayers; the overseer under the supervision of the 12 had general care over the church as a whole and had assistance overseers to care for the affairs of the church in states, territories, or various countries as the need required; the helpers gave themselves to the advancement of the work and the truth, as the Lord had given them talents and opportunities; and the disciples gave themselves wholly into the Lord's hands to use as he will...

"Church of God" (Adventist)

In the year 1863 there were many people in various parts of the United States who held the observance of the seventh day Sabbath and were looking for the soon return of Christ, but who either had never been connected with the Seventh Day Adventist, or who had rejected the inspiration of the many "visions" of Mrs. E. G. White.

These people were scattered and unorganized. In the summer of 1863 a number of them associated together and began the publication of a monthly paper, named "The Hope of Israel", the first issue was dated August 10, 1863, and was issued from Hartford, Michigan. Enos Easton was editor and Samuel Davison and Gilbert Granmer were leaders of the work. Some of those supporting the paper were loosely organized under the name "Church of Christ" while others held to the name "Church of God", but they were united in faith in the soon coming of Christ and a number of other doctrines, and also were opposed to accepting the "visions" of Mrs. E. G. White. The paper was soon moved to Waverly,

Michigan, where publication continued at Marion, lowa, by an association of some of the original group, and others who had joined with them, under the name "Christian Publishing Association", the movement had received fresh impetus through two prominent Adventist ministers, who had refused to accept the inspiration of Mrs. E. G. White joining with them. These were B. F. Snook and W. H. Brinkerhoff, who with W. E. Carver, were the leaders of the revived work. Later Jacob Brinkerhoff became one of the principal leaders. The name "Church of God" was then in general use by these brethren and soon was adopted as a distinctive name. The ministers were practically all evangelists, and local churches were established throughout the country.

The history of the church is closely connected with the history of the publication which continued to be published in Marion, lowa, until the year 1889, when it was moved to Stanberry, Missouri. The name of the paper was changed several times, and it is now known as "The Bible Advocate and Herald of the Coming Kingdom".

"Some of the churches formed remained independent from the general organization, although holding the same beliefs. In 1906 these were registered as a separate body under the title of Churches of God (Adventist) unattached congregation. Many independent groups

still exist.

"The organized conferences employ evangelists who work for the spreading of the gospel and the building up of the chruch in their ter-Work in unorganized territories is conducted by the general conference, with funds given or allotted for that purpose.

SOIL RECLAIMED ON DEAD SEA SHORES

HAIFA. - The Jewish National Fund has reclaimed 20 dunams of farm land in Nahal Kalya, on the Dead Sea shore, using peat

from the Hula Valley.

This was reported in an issue of "Israel Farmers", which appeared yesterday. The journal states that the salination problem was overcome by washing the soil repeatedly, and then the peat was used to enrich it.

34,000 WORKERS FROM THE AREAS WORK IN ISRAEL

Some 34,000 residents of the administered areas were employed in Israel last year, compared to 21,000 in 1970. The increase in the numbers employed rose steadily throughout the year and reached 39,000 in the last quarter of 1971, the Central Bureau of Statistics reported yesterday.

About 26,000 of the total were from the West Bank and 8,000 from the Gaza Strip. These people represented 19 per cent of the total work force of the administered areas.

The building trades absorbed almost 70 per cent of the workers, compared to 47 per cent in 1970. Some 10 per cent were employed in agriculture, and 20 per cent in industry.

> NEW GOSPEL CLAIM FOR DEAD SEA SCROLL

Rome (UPI). - A Spanish professor's claim to have found a fragment of St. Mark's Gospel among the Dead Sea Scrolls could shed light on New Testament research, Bible experts said this week.

The professor, the Rev. Jose O'Callaghan, suggested that a part of Mark 6, 52-53 - which comes immediately after Jesus' walking on the Sea of Galilee - can be reconstructed from a previously unidentified papyrus fragment found among the scrolls.

He suggested that the fragment dates from the year 50 C.E., based on the style of writing and the date of other fragments which already

have been identified.

In addition, the fragment would be the oldest piece of New Ttestament writing ever found. The record until now has been held by a fragment of St. John's Gospel, found in Egypt and dated at around 135, C.E.

5,000 JEWS LEFT RUSSIA SO FAR THIS YEAR

MOSCOW (AP). - More than 5,000 Soviet Jews have left the country so far this year, knowledgeable sources reported yesterday.

They said that if the present rate of Jewish emigration were maintained for the rest of the year, an unofficial target of 30,000 departures could be attained.

The sources said about 2,300 Jews went to Israel from the Soviet Union in January, an-

other 2,200 left last month and about 1,00 have departed so far this month.

In a Dunkirk-like operation early yesterday some 20,000 Three-Day Marchers were eva cuated by buses and trucks from rain-deluge encampments after the march was cancelled be

fore its second day.

The decision to call off the event after only one day was taken before dawn as heavy down pours turned the main encampment at Beit-E and the Gadna encampment in Jerusalem into shambles of mud and collapsed tents. Invoking a pre-planned contingency plan, the army uti lized 350 buses and 100 military trucks to picl up the marchers, some of whom waited hour. in the driving rain for evacuation.

Gadna First

The operation was first implemented in the Gadna encampment where 7,000 high schoo youths had set up their own tents in Emek Zion during the day under intermittent rain

When the rainfall resumed in the evening thousands of other marchers called it quits. By 2 o'clock, 8,000 of the approximately 20,000 persons at the camp had left by bus for Jerusa lem, Egged dispatching 100 vehicles to the camp as the pressure built up. Many of the 650 cars which had brought marchers to the encampment also left during the night.

1,200 Foreigners

The 1,200 overseas participants in the march, who spent the night in barracks and not in tents, were reportedly in good spirits despite the cancellation yesterday of the event, and promised that they would be back next year.

TWO TERRORISTS AND GIRL, 15, KILLED IN STRIP

KHAN YUNIS. - Two terrorists - one of them reportedly high on the wanted list - and a 15-year-old girl were shot and killed by security forces at Ma'an village near here early Friday morning. The wanted terrorist was hiding in a house in the village, disguised as a woman. The security forces surrounded the house and called on the occupants to come out with their hands up.

One man emerged making a suspicious movement with his hands, and the soldiers shot and killed him. Immediately afterwards another man and a girl tried to escape from the house. They were also shot and killed after failing to heed

the soldiers' challenge.

Investigation revealed that the first man had been a member of the Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine for the past three years and was wanted for the murder of an Israeli Arab and the "mukhtar" of Beit Lahiyeh, north of here, as well as for numerous acts of sabotage.

JDL GIRL DRENCHES SOVIET OFFICIAL WITH BLOOD

WASHINGTON (Reuter). — A young woman, member of the Jewish Defence League, threw one litre of human blood over the head of a Soviet embassy official here to protest the Kremlin's Jewish emigration policy. The incident occurred during a reception for diplomats on Wednesday night.

A JDL spokesman identified the girl as "Miss Judith Sothoro", a 17-year-old liberal arts stu-

dent.

He said the diplomat, Alexander Yevstafyev, a press counsellor at the Embassy, was drenched in blood and had to change his clothes.

The spokesman said the blood was taken from Miss Sothoro and two other students "who wanted to join this act of symbolizing the plight of Soviet Jewry".

INFLOW OF CAPITAL IS ON THE RISE

Capital inflow to Israel is on the rise — but this does not apply to industrial investments, according to Mr. Yashayahu Stopper, head of

the Investment Centre.

Total approvals last year were IL2,610 m., as against IL1,770 m. in 1970. Most striking is the increase in foreign currency placements—up 40 per cent, from \$96.7 m. to \$135.3 m. (The reference is to projects approved by the Investment Centre for tax rebates under the Capital Investments Law.)

The sum divides as follows:

1) \$115 m. brought in by immigrants and temporary residents, as against \$55 m. in 1970;

2) \$179.5 m. in gifts pensions and legacies, as against \$114 m. (this refers mainly to newcomers, also, including a respectable number of retired Americans);

3) \$110 m. of private investment, as against \$81 m. (part of the personal transfers likewise

find their way to investment).

J.D.L. PROTEST AGAINST JAFFA "MISSIONARIES"

The Jewish Defence League's Israel branch has launched a campaign against missionary activity. According to "Yediot Aharonot" reporter Noah Klieger, J.D.L. members, led by their secretary Yosef Schneider, staged a demonstration on Wednesday evening at a bookstore run by the "Hebrew Christians", 42 Rehov Yefet in Jaffa. The shop is managed by Mrs. Sarah Ostrovsky.

The J.D.L. claimed that the "Hebrew Christians" are trying to proselytize immigrants who are staying at a Jewish Agency hostel located

in the same building.

After sticking posters on the shop window proclaiming: "These are Missionaries", the demonstrators entered the shop, which contains religious literature in many languages, including Russian, English and Spanish. They demanded that Mrs. Ostrovsky cease her "missionary activities". Speaking fluent Hebrew, Mrs. Ostrovsky vehemently denied the charges and tried to evict the young men from her

Finally she called the police, who requested her and three of the demonstrators to go down to headquarters to give evidence.

J.D.L. members announced that they would continue to "harass" missionaries throughout the

country.

BIG GROUP HERE OF SOVIET "OLIM"

LOD AIRPORT. — A large group of Soviet immigrants arrived here before dawn yesterday. They came from Leningrad, Kiev, Minsk and Chernovitz, as well as from various cities in Georgia and Lituania.

TERRORISTS GET LIFE FOR SIX MURDERS

GAZA. — Three terrorists from the Burej refugee camp south of here received sentences of life imprisonment with hard labour in the military court here yesterday, for committing a total of six murders.

The accused told the court that the motive in all six murders was to punish cooperation with

the Israel authorities.

ARCHAEOLOGISTS ARGUE OVER DATING METHODS

Lively debates, particularly over problems of dating, marked the opening sessions in Jerusalem yesteday of Israel's first Archaeological Congress. Taking part are 110 professional archaeologist, 200 Government Antiquities Department "trustees" mostly members of kibbutzim — and 100 archaeology students of the Hebrew and Tel Aviv Universities.

Lectures were given simultaneously in three separate lecture halls at the Van Leer Foundation, divided by period: Palaeolithic, Early and Middle Bronze Ages; Late Bronze and Israelite Periods; and Hellenistic to Middle Ages.

WORLD BANK TO LEND ISRAEL \$90 M.

LOD AIRPORT. — The World Bank will lend Israel \$90 m. for the development of sewage systems, agriculture and industry, Bank of Israel Governor Mr. Moshe Sanbar told reporters here on his return from the U.S.A. yesterday.

The loans will be granted over the coming three years (for sewage in 1972, for agriculture in 1973 and for industry in 1974). They will carry an interest rate of 7 1/4 per cent for

20 years.

350 RUSSIAN IMMIGRANTS

350 Russian immigrants families have settled in Beersheba to date, and many more Russian families have asked to be settled there, it was learned yesterday. The Beersheba Municipality is preparing apartments, which will be available in April, for the abrosption of additional families from the Soviet Union.

No casualties were reported. The patrol returned fire.



41,500 TOURISTS CAME IN FEBRUARY

A total of 41,500 tourists visited Israel in February — 46 per cent more than in February, 1971 — the Centrad Bureau of Statistics and the Ministry of Tourism announced yesterday. According to the joint announcement, the monthly arrivals level continues to grow, and the monthly average now stands at approximately 65,000.

The figures also showed that about 126,000 tourists came in the last three months, compared with 86,000 in the comparable period a year earlier.
