THE LAST GENERATION IN BIBLE PROPHECY

No. 4

There are many different opinions about the number of years that constitute a generation, and it is always known that a generation is from father to son, but this is far from being definite as to the number of years. It is best to use the scriptures to give this answer.

The Heavenly Father did not intend to leave us in the dark about this important question mentioned particularly by the Saviour concerning His coming and the end of this age.

One religious denomination in particular made a very special message out of this subject, following the great meteoric shower, known as the "falling of the stars" in 1833, and following to 1844, as well as many years afterwards. They had read only the narrative given by Matthew of his great sermon of Christ, and based their argument on the dark day of 1789 and the falling of the stars in 1833, claiming that people living to see those unusual phenomena, would live to see the return of the Saviour, that He would come during that generation.

In-as-much, however, as those people are all dead, who were living in that period, they quite naturally have dropped this subject out of their teaching. They have not yet discovered that other witnesses besides Matthew also told us about this great sermon of the Master.

THE LAST EVENTS ANNOUNCED BY LUKE

Luke brought to us another portion of the discourse, which Matthew left out. It was about the ending of Gentile times — the Jews being dispersed among all nations UNTIL the times of the Gentiles were fulfilled: of the distress of nations; of the great perplexity; of Men's

hearts failing them for fear; and of THE POWERS C THE HEAVENS BEING SHAKEN, which were the very last events to take place just before He was to a pear in the clowds of heaven, returning as He went awa. This generation now (seeing these things is not to paraway till the Messiah returns.

Matthew also mentioned, "The powers of the heaver being shaken as the last event (Matt. 24:29), but the dear people, living in 1844, loved their Saviour and wan ed to see Him come in their day, which no doubt eause them to overlook, the great subject of the Jew, of he dispersal among the nations, with His returning to Jurusalem, and Esau the Arabs no longer in possessic of the Holy Land, that was to be trodden down by the Gentiles during the period of Gentiles times, when the gospel was to be preached as a witness to all nation before the end.

We are instructed that, "By the mouth of two or three witnesses shall every word be established". — 2 Cor. 13: So many make the mistake in establising their prophetic, and doctrinal teaching of consulting only one witness and then drawing their conclusion, when if they had mo carefully consulted all who had spoken on the subject, would have been revealed to them in a different light.

In order to rightly sum up the last events of this Ge tile age before the return of the Master, it is necessary read the narrative of both Matthew and Luke. Find o what each one says about the events to transpire befo "the powers of the Heavens are shaken", by the atom and hydrogen bomb as they are being shaken toda. Then we will know what generation it is that, "shall n pass away till ALL be fulfilled".

LONDON (JTO). — A series of Vienna newspaper articles on "The Jews in Austria" has led to an "ominous resurgence" of anti-Semitism in that country, the London "Financial Times" correspondent reports. The Austrian Press Council has decided to hold an investigation into the series which reportedly set off a spate of anti-Semitic incidents.

LIBYA SAYS IT GAVE ARABS 70 MIGS IN OCTOBER WAR

RABAT (AP). — Libya contributed more than half a billion dollars in aid, including 400 combat missions and 70 new Soviet Mig-21 air-planes, to the Arabs in the October war, a Tripoli newspaper claims.

The newspaper "Al Fatah" — The Conqueror — said official documents backed up its figures, released to "reply to detractors of Libya".

Libya had provided \$542,164,000 in aid before the war broke out on October 6, it said, "without counting the mobilization of all the nation's potential to respond to any request from an Arab frontline nation, ranging from aircraft to bath soap and including heavy equipment".

SOVIET SECT ASKS NIXON TO HELP

MOSCOW (UPI). — Nearly 200 Pentecost sect members, saying they are persecuted for their faith, appealed to President Nixon yesterday to help them win the right to emigrate to the United States.

Two sect members, Grigori Vashenko and Yevgeni Bresenden, made available to Western newsmen an open letter to Nixon signed by 188 members of the Christian Evangelical sect. They said there are about 100,000 Pentecost members in the Soviet Union and many of them would leave if allowed to do so.

The Pentecosts said they are subjected to fines for performing religious services and some members have been imprisoned for terms up to 10 years.

ASHDOD CITRUS SEASON ENDS

ASHDOD. — Some 22 million crates of citrus fruit were exported through Ashdod Port this season, slightly more than last year, despite the war and the manpower and transport shortage. This was announced here yesterday by port spokesman Haim Shushan at the close of the current season.

WORLD GRAIN SUPPLIES NEAR DANGEROUS LOW

UNITED NATIONS, N.Y. (AP). — World grain reserves have dipped to the point where rich and poor

countries alike will depend "on the vagaries of a sing year's weather" for adequate supplies, a U.N. group we told Wednesday.

Remaining stocks no longer provide an adequate buffer against crop failure, declared E. M. Ojala, assistant director of the world Food and Agriculture Organization

He said food supplies for millions during the coming year thus will depend almost entirely on 1973 harvest

SHORTCOMINGS IN HOUSING ARE NO LIKELY TO GO AWAY

The provision of adequate housing ranks high amor our economic priorities. The most telling slogan in domonstrations of discontent is not "work" or "bread", bu "flats for young couples". Accordingly, public spendir on housing occupies pride of place after defence.

In spite of pressing emergency needs, the authoritienvisage a substantial expansion of residential constrution in the coming years as a precondition to improvir our welfare standards. Even now we are allocating housing 40 per cent of our gross investment, double the annual combined investment in industry, agriculture, ar power plants.

A massive residential construction effort, conceivab coupled with improved urban development schemes, wi inevitably, therefore, lead to a general demand for bett housing, thus increasing the gap between demand ar supply.

Two soldiers were killed by artillery fire on Tuesda and five more wounded yesterday as fighting along the northern front continued.

. AVOCADO, CARROT EXPORTS RISE

TEL AVIV. — Some 10,500 tons of avocados were exported this year, 1,500 tons more than expected. France bought up about 65 per cent of the crop.

Agrexco is now trying to find new markets and increa the export of avocados. According to estimates, the avcado yield in another four years will be about 30,000 tor and 75 per cent of this will be exported.

Simcha Ofer, head of the vegetable department of A rexco, announced that Israel's carrots have been very we received in Scandinavia this year; they have importe 3,000 tons, compared with 1,200 tons last year.

FARM OUTPUT UP IN JUDEA, SAMARIA

There has been a 30 per cent increase in farm prodution in Judea and Samaria in the past three years — fro IL. 345 m. in 1971-72 to IL. 450 m. in 1973-74, it w reported by the Director-General of the Agriculture Ministry, Avraham Brum.

Regional agricultural advisers, who had also served up der the Jordanian administration, told Mr. Brum the production levels of the Arab farmers would match the of Israelis within a few years. They said this was largely due to increased mechanization and improved irrigation methods.

WHAT ABOUT MISSIONARIES IN ISRAEL

Many of the missionaries in Israel take their stand with the Catholics and Protestants that Jerusalem should be an international city under the United Nations instead of the Capital City of Israel. Some teach contrary to the Jewish religion on the subject of the Godhead. The Sabbath and the Law. They use swines flesh for food. Believe in the cross as a sign of true Christianity when instead it is a sign of heathen intolerance used by the Babylonians and Romans to torture their enemies more than a thousand years B.C.

Many teach that they are the true Israelites who should possess this land, and that the people here called Israel are a mongrel race, and not even Jews, also

that Jerusalem will be destroyed again.

The government of Israel however regardless of this is tolerant toward all religion, and grants the free exercise thereof the same as in the U.S.A. It is necessary to closely watch missionaries, however, because many spies have been caught here disguising themselves as missionaries. Furthermore at different times certain missionaries have induced Jews to leave the country, providing them with means on the ground of their pretended conversion to the faith of that particular sect. The government naturally is not pleased with this kind of work because much money has been spent to bring these immigrants here, provide homes, and take care of them.

Also some missionaries take children of poor families and put them in Christian missions where they are taught the law was abolished and nailed to the cross. "The Benerter" and those connected with it are opposed to such work and unscriptural teaching. We teach that Jewish children are far better when left in Jewish schools where the law and true Sabbath is taught, than they are to be placed in mission schools and taught the abolition of the Holy Ten Commandments.

Such teaching is morally degrading, breeding criminals, and filling penetentaries and insane asylums to

overflowing.

PAST CURSES AND FUTURE BLESSINGS FOR ALL PEOPLE

Exion saith, 'the Lord hath forsaken me, and my Lord hath forgotten me'. Can a woman forget her sucking child, that she should not have compassion on the son of her womb? Yea, they may forget. Yet will I not forget thee". — Isaiah 49: 14-15.

Many texts of scripture could be brought forth to show how the Lord has chosen Mount Zion in Jerusalem for his dwelling place. Therefore we may expect without diasppointment that many good things are now in store for her, since we have passed through the period of judgments and curses so numerously declared throughout the scriptures because of sin and wickedness within her borders.

We will notice just a few scriptures as follows: "Thy holy cities are a wilderness, Zion is a wilderness, Jerusalem a desolation". — Isa. 6: 10.

"They build up with blood, and Jerusalem with iniquity... Therefore shall Zion for your sake be ploughed as a field, and Jerusalem shall become heaps, and the mountain of the house, as the high place of the forest". — Micah 3: 11-12.

Then as we continue to read right on it says: "But in the last days it shall come to pass that the mountain (government) of the house of the Lord shall be established in the top of the mountains, and it shall be exalted above the hills, and people shall flow into it".

Here is another very significant, and well known prophecy which is now in its process of fulfillment. The scripture reads: "Thou shalt arise and have mercy upon Zion, for the time to favor her, yea, the set time is come. For thy SERVANTS take pleasure in her stones, and favor the dust thereof. So the heathen (not the Father's children) shall fear the name of the Lord, and all the kings of the earth thy glory.

When the Lord shall build up Zion, He shall appear in His glory. He will regard the prayer of the desitute, and not dispise their prayers. This shall be written for the generations to come, and the people that shall be created shall praise the name of the Lord". — Psalms 102: 13 to 18.

Just before the coming of the Lord to judge the world, he gives a definite command to sound the alarm of His pending judgments from Mount Zion. This command is given through the prophet Joel, as follows: "Blow ye the trumpet in Zion, and sound an alarm in my Holy Mountain. Let all the inhabitants of the land tremble, for the day of the Lord cometh, for it is nigh at hand". — Joel 2: 1.

The remnant people are not only commanded to give out the alarm from Mount Zion in Jerusalem, but they are also commanded to call a solemn assembly there. This scripture reads as follows: "Blow the trumpet in Zion, sanctify a fast, call a solemn assembly. Gather the people, sanctify the congregation, assemble the elders, gather the children and those that suck the breasts. Let the bridegroom go forth of his chamber, and the bride out of her closet. Let the priests, the ministers of the Lord weep between the porch and the altar, and let them say spare thy people, O Lord."

THE YEARS IN A GENERATION

There was a definite purpose in the Father revealing to us, through his Spirit the information of the following text: "So all the generations from Abraham to David are (14) generations; and from David until the carrying away into Babylon are (14) generations; and from the carrying away into Babylon unto Christ are [14] generations. — Matt. 1:17. /___

We have here a total of three times 14 or 42 generations from Abraham to Christ. It is therefore a very simple matter to find how many years there are in a generation.

You will observe at the top of the page in most Bibles the date when events of that page occurred, you will find that from the time Abraham's name was changed from Abram to Abraham, (to) Christ was 1890 years. In asmuch-as this period represents 42 generations, it is a very simple problem to find the number of years in one generation. By dividing this entire period into 42 parts we have 45 years in each generation.

Now let us go back to the prophecy of Daniel concerning the "Abomination of Desolation", to which Christ directed us in order to know about His coming and the end of the age. - Matt 24: 15.

Here we find the last generation. Why did Gabriel divide this 1335 year period into two parts, cutting our exactly 45 years, just one generation, and pronouncing a BLESSING on those who would wait and come to the end of these days? There was no other reason, only that the wise would understand, and know very near the time for the great resurrection, when the sleeping saints of all ages would come forth and live again. - See Daniel 12: 10-13. See a right hand above page-3-

WE WILL KNOW OUR LOVED ONES THERE

When all who may read this, and children, fathers, mothers, brothers, sisters, wives, or husbands sleeping in death, who loved the Father, and served Him, will see them again and dear ones: "We shall know one another there, as we knew them here. Yes, this glorious time is veary near at hand when these precious jewels that once adorned our homes, will be found again, but in a more resplendent setting, gleaming in the bright supernal glory, of endless life and light.

Praise His Holy Name for making such wonderful provisions for the children of men. Remember what the Master said that when we see THESE THINGS (the very events we see today coming to pass', to LOOK UP, LIFT YOUR HEADS FOR YOUR REDEMPTION DRAWETH NIGH. Like the building of the trees at spring time is certain proof, that summer is near at hand, so likewise when we see these things. He says we are to know that the "KINGDOM" OF GOD IS NEAR AT HAND". — Luke 21:31.

This is indeed a very simple prophecy. It is not complex or hard to understand. "The wise shall understand". It is for the very last days of this age. It reaches to the time when Daniel shall 'Stand in His lot". - Daniel 12: 13. This is the great resurrection time for all the righteous from the days of Adam. — I Cor. 15: 51-55, I Thes. 4: 15-18; Isa. 26:9; Daniel 12: 1,2; etc.

The Abomination of Desolation or the Esau Mohammedan era commenced 622 A.D. This is when all these Esau-Mohammedan countries surrounding Israel including Egypt begin their era. All histories and encyclopaedias agree with this date called the "Hegira". Look up the word in your dictionary, and see the date for yourself. MA'ALOT. — Israeli troops yesterday stormed the school building here where three Arab terrorists held 85 children hostage and killed the gunmen in a brief gunfight which left 20 persons, mostly children, dead and about 70 pupils wounded, nine seriously. The dead included 16 children, three members of a family killed early in the morning and a soldier who had been taking pictures from the nearby water tower.

The longest and bloodiest day of terror yet suffered by the country ended at the Netive Meir School where the children 15 to 18 on a vacation outing had spent the night and where the terrorists had burst in before dawn—holding them hostage and demanding the release of 20 terrorists held in Israeli jails whom they wanted to be flown to Damascus.

When the bloody day was over, it was still difficult to reconstruct events precisely. The three terrorists who had infiltrated from Lebanon, started their day of massacre at about midnight, when dressed in khaki looking like soldiers they attacked a van on is way home with women workers from the Ata Textile Plant, near Haifa. Two women were killed and six others wourded, two seriously.

The terrorists then made their way over the hills to Ma'alot and entered a dwelling block, number 134, which faces the Netiv Meir State Religious School building that dominates the city from a hillside. The terrorists went from door to door ordering tenants in Hebrew to open up, claiming to be police checking for terrorists. Most of the residents refused to open their doors and were saved, but the three men got into the second floor flat of the Cohen family, where they murdered three.

The father, Zion, 37, and the older son Eliyahu, 4 they shot dead, seriously injured the five-year-old girl, Miriam. But they chased the seven-monins-pregnant mother Fortuna, who fled down the stairs screaming for help, and shot her dead, her blood staining the steps.

They then entered the building where the boys and girls, most of them from the Safad religious school and about 15 from Hatzor, were sleeping on separate floors, accompanied by a girl junior army officer, a teacher, a couple of instructors and two soldiers who had come along but had left their rifles outside in the excursion truck — apparently in line with instructions not to sleep with their guns.

In the confusion which ensued when the terrorists herded all the children into the first floor classroom, 17 of the children, the truck driver, a teacher, and an instructor managed to escape by jumping out of the windows.

Later in the morning, the terrorists released the girl officer, Narkis Mordechao, sending her out with an ultimatum, a list of the 20 top terrorists they wanted released. They named 11 in the list spelled out in Latin letters. They also gave her a leaflet in Arabic and Engish, setting out the aims of their organization and action. They demanded that three of the top terrorists choose the remaning nine to be released. They set 6

p.m. as the dealine, by which time they wanted the released terrorists to be in Damascus.

Protracted negotiations were directed by the Defence Minister, the Chief of Staff and the O.C., Northern Command, who set up a forward command post near the school early in the morning. They were joined later by the French Ambassador at the the terrorists' demand. An army unit assaulted the building to prevent the terrorists blowing it up with the 85 children they still held.

Mr. Dayan, joined by the Chief of Staff and the O.C. Northern Command, set up their advanced HQ near the school, and negotiations got under way with the terrorists who, through loud hailers, threatened to blow up the building at six if their demands were not met.

The terrorists used the hailers brought along by the pupils for the outing, and spoke in Arabic and Hebrew, demanding the presence of the French or Rumanian ambassador, with a secret code word that was to be broadcast by Radio Damascus, after the terrorist prisoners were released.

Meanwhile, the terrorists fired occasional shots whenever anybody was spotted by them coming close to the building. At about 11, a Ma'alot soldier on leave, who had crept near to take photos, was shot and killed by them.

The Government decided to release the twenty terrorist prisoners to save the lives of the children, but the code words the terrorists had sent to the French and Rumanian ambassadors were slow in getting through, and it was impossible to carry out their demands by the dead line of 6 p.m.

The following is from the Chief of Staff:

Chief of Staff Rav Aluf Mordechai Gur said last night that Israel had done everything humanly possible to secure the release of the 85 schoolchildren being held hostage by three terrorists in Ma'alot, without having to storm the school.

"We were totally committed to handing over the terrorists held in Israeli prisons as the three attackers had demanded", he said, "but as a result of their adamant refusal to prolong the deadline, and our belief that if we did not meet the deadline they would have blown themselves up together with the children, we were forced to do as we did".

"Never before in my life", said Gur, "have I tried so hard to persuade anyone as I tried yesterday to persuade the terrorists to postpone their deadline and to give us the extra time necessary to fly the released prisoners out of Israel."

Israel had taken the decision early in the day, he said, to meet the terrorists' demands, but it was not until late in the afternoon that their demands became clear. Throughout the day Chief of Intelligence Aluf Shlomo Gazit and the Rumanian ambassador to Israel maintained contact with the terrorist headquarters in Beirut.

One of the main problems facing Israel was that the terrorists plan was totally inflexible in that they were cut off from their headquarters and could not be reached without the code-word. He said their inflexibility left no room for manoeuvre, and he described the ter-

rorists' plan for the mutual exchange as a "mission impossible".

During the afternoon, he said, Israel had made arrangements for a U.N. plane to fly the terrorists to Damascus. The U.N. had placed a plane at Israel's disposal, he said, and while this was luckily already at Jerusalem's Atarot airport, it had still to be unloaded. The plane could not have taken off with the prisoners before 5.30 p.m. and would not have reached Damascus before 7.00 p.m. (Israel time) — one hour after the terrorists deadline.

"It was absolutely impossible to meet their conditions in the time left to us', he said, "and this coupled with our belief that the three terrorists had every intention of carrying out their threat, forced us to make the agonizing decision to storm the school."

Fefore the day ended in tragedy several persons offered tremselves as hostages instead of the children, including the deputy mayors of Safad and Hatzor. But their offers were rejected by the terrorists. Amnon Lin, K.M., who is well known among Israeli Arabs, also made the offer and figured that if one of the three was indeed a former Israeli, his name might strike a note, but the army would not forward it to the terrorists.

Meanwhile, a strong force of soldiers was stationed around the school building. But everything remained quiet, with the exception of occasional shots from the school, until the storming of the building was made at 5.25 p.m.

When the soldiers entered the building they found bombs at every door set to go off at six p.m., which they defused before going up the steps.

At this time as "The Jerusalem Post" expressed it, "all Hell Broke Law". The terrorists began shooting and throwing hand grenades among the crowded screaming children spraying them with machinegun fire.

The assault squad stormed dp the stairs, while others climbed up ladders at the windows. They killed one of the terrorists on the spot and wounded the other two. Within minutes the shooting was over and the ambulances started screaming down the streets, as stretcher bearers were seen rushing from the smoking school.

Then the day-long tension developed into almost general hysteria, with some of the local soldiers who had brothers or sister in the school also breaking down. As Mr. Dayan moved out, he was again surrounded by a crowd demanding vengeance. A group of several dozen men and women broke through the barriers into the school yard and demanded to be given the bodies of the three terrorists, who were the only ones then left inside. They insisted that one of the men was only injured and demanded that he be thrown out to them. Some also wanted to harm the other bodies. The soldiers refused.

The soldiers finally had to display the bodies to persuade the last of the angry demonstrators to disperse.

UNDER HAIL OF BULLETS AT MA'ALOT BROTHER, SISTER SAVE EACH OTHER

SAFAAD. — Galil Maimon, a 21-year-old disabled exsoldier, yesterday described how he had carried his wounded young sister out of the Ma'alot school last Wednesday under a hail of gunfire — after his sister had saved him from a terrorist bullet.

Galil, who runs a TV service shop here, said that his mother had woken him at 6 o'clock on Wednesday, and

anxiously told him that his sister Zippora, 15, was being held by terrorists at Ma'alot. He immediately jumped into his car and "drove like mad" to Ma'alot. But as a civilian he could not get past the police barriers. Borrowing an army shirt from a soldier to whom he had given a lift, he worked his way up to the advance line of troops facing the school.

"I saw four children at the window and tried to encourage them by waving to them", Galil said. One of the terrorists took a shot at him, "which passed a few centimetres over my head".

Later he learned that the terrorist had pointed him out to the children and told them he would "shoot him down". His sister who had not recognised him, jumped at the terrorists and pushed him to deflect his aim, thus possibly saving Galil's life.

He stayed with the force, not eating or drinking, until 5.25 in the evening, when the Israeli assault began. "I closed my eyes, clenched my fists and ran forward. The soldiers tried to stop me two or three times, shouting at me that it was enough that my sister was in mortal danger, without my endangering myself as well. But no force could have stopped me. I charged on towards the school. A volley of bullets hit the ground near my feet and I stopped to take shelter behind a tree. Then I heard a single shot from inside the school and the terrible cries of the children. I said to myself, better to die with them, and started running forward again.

"I jumped over a fence and into the school yard. There I started screaming 'Zipi, Zipi, are you still alive?' Later it turned out that she had spotted me and jumped out of the window to get to me. She fell, hit by grenade fragments, injured in the spine, arm and foot. I found her lying under the window, crying, unable to crawl towards me. I took her in my arms and started running back. I ran sideways to shield her with my back from the rain of bullets. Fortunately, they did not hit us."

Galil said that all the way back Zipi had shouted at him: "Leave me, I can manage, there are more seriously wounded girls inside."

"I only grasped her closer and ran like mad to cover the last 500 metres away from the school. When I made it the boys started kissing me and slapping my back. We put Zipi in a jeep, which rushed her to the first aid station".

He tried to return to the school to rescue more children, but this time the soldiers pinned him down and stopped him. "I don't think I did anything heroic. Any person with human feeling would have done the same, had he heard those terrible screams," Galil said.

He had been badly wounded in the shoulder in 1970. During the Yom Kippur war he tried to volunteer, but was rejected. Borrowing an army uniform, he went to the Golan, where he evacuated wounded soldiers in his car, twice narrowly escaping being killed.

TERRORIST BASES UP TO BEIRUT

The Israel Air Force yesterday afternoon twice attacked terrorist concentrations in Lebanon and, according to reports from Beirut, inflicted heavy casualties.

The first wave of planes attacked a training base of the Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine some 10 klms. south of Beirut at 3:30, the strafing lasting half According to an announcement from the Army Spokesman, all planes returned safely to base.

The targets attacked included offices, training base headquarters and workshops belonging to the Fatah, the Habash wing of the Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine and the Popular Democratic Front under Nayef Hawatmeh — which was responsible for the Ma'alot massacre.

Meanwhile along the Syrian front yesterday, four soldiers were wounded by Syrian artillery, which fell in the Bulge, on the southern Golan and the Hermon range. In the morning, the Syrians shelled the Ein Zivan area on the southern Golan, causing little damage. There were no casualties.

Hardest hit yesterday was the northern sector of the Bulge in the Mazrat Beit Jann region where hundreds of shells fell in the late morning and early afternoon.

Dozens of persons were killed and scores wounded in yesterday's Israel air raids, according to reports from Beirut. Lebanese authorities said the exact number could not be counted by early last evening.

VALUE OF RAW FOOD BY ATERHOV T. HOVANNESSIAN OF TEHERAN, IRAN

The most serious, stubborn and seemingly incurable diseases, the causes of which are often declared to be unknown, including cancer and cardio vascular which immediately yield to an abstemious diet of raw-eating.

In the world of raw-eaters the fear of mi-

crobes ceases to exist.

These truths are further supported by numerous news-papers and periodicals. Thus the Moscow journal called "Science and Life" confessed in its March, 1965 issue that there are many raw-eaters among its readers, who have been cured of various diseases and have informed the editors of the full details of their recovery

A number of clear-sighted doctors have be-

come raw-eaters.

The best proof of the truth of my viewpoint is the irrefutable fact that RAW-EATING IS. FOR ALL DISEASES WITHOUT ANY EXCEPTION.

A vast amount of concrete and indisputable evidence has recently come to hand in support of this statement. Raw vegetable nutriments produce normal, healthy and active cells, whereas cooked and unnatural foodstuffs bring into being accumulations of sickly, useless and inactive cells along with various poisonous substances.

In general, diseases are nothing but the starvation of the organs of the body for natural nourishment and a lack of active cells on the one hand, and an accumulation of parasitic and inactive cells and various toxic materials on the other hand. In order to free ones self from diseases it is essential to restore the necessary complement of the former by the help of natural nutriments, and to starve and destroy the latter by stopping the consumption of cooked food.

By the process of cooking the living vegetable nutriment loses its nutritional properties and is converted into substances that induce addictions to tobacco, alcohol and opium.

Through cooking and refining the "civilized" man of today destroys eighty per cent of the

foodstuffs produced by the soil.

Besides ensuring perfect health and long life (from 150 to 200 years), raw-eating frees mankind from all sorts of economic worries, extirpates every type of addiction from the face of this earth, enables the soul of man, restrains his beastly inclinations, calms his passions and imbues him with the spirit of humanitarianism and the love of peace.

The newspaper "AVANGUARD," which is published in Erivan, the capital of Armenia, writes in one of its issues (1964, No. 98). A number of engineers, musicians and painters, all of whom are men of education, have become raw-eaters. They assure you that they feel so light and healthy that they do not perspire and do not feel the palpitations of their hearts." Later information indicates that a large number of patients in Erivan and Moscow have recovered from serious illnesses. Similar evidence have come from America, England, Switzerland, Holland, Israel and several other countries.

Every recruit to raw-eating insures himself against ill health for the rest of his life and at the same time he effects a welcome economy of no less thon 50 per cent in cost of his diet.

NUTRITIONIST ASKS GLOBAL EFFORT TO CURB FAMINE.

"If there were two bad drought years in a row in the United States", the biologist said, "then there could be a very, very massive famine in parts of the world that depend on food gifts."

The United States, he said, has been very fortunate in recent years in avoiding such droughts. However, Harrar and other agricultural scientists here in U.S.A. have indicated that the nation may be due for some lean food production years.

The nations that would be hardest hit by any such dry spell in the U.S., he said, would be India, Pakistan, Bangaladesh, the Philippines, Indonesia and the smaller countries of Africa, such as Nigeria

These nations, he said, are "skating on thin ice".

Questions And Answers

OUESTION. -

Please explain all the feast days of Israel. ANSWER. —

The 'feast days' or holidays of Israel are different from those of any other nations because of her long past history and miraculous leadings of the direct intervention of heaven. No other nation on earth has holidays to commemorate heaven's direct intervention and miraculous deliverance. The "feast and fast" days of Israel stem from such events.

As Israel was then the chosen nation, the people of Elohim, there surely would be nothing wrong for His people wheever, or wherever they are, to keep these holidays in mind, and follow Israel in commemorating them with fasting and prayer.

QUESTION. —

Why did the Saviour command the apostles to pray about the Sabbath, not to take flight from Jerusalem on that day when He knew the city would not be destroyed for many years?

ANSWER. -

This is a very hard question to answer by those who do not reverance this same Sabbath now, but who have substituted in its place the day of the Sun: Sunday, set apart as a day of rest by the Roman emperor Constantine to please the heathen Sun worshipers. The Saviour knew the people would have to carry burdens from their homes when they fled to the mountains as He commanded them to do, He always reverenced the Sabbath during his ministry (Luke 6:1-9, and He knew it was the only day that His Father had blessed and set apart for His children to Remember and keep holy. Therefore He gave this command to His apostles.

QUESTION. -

Does the "Common Market" have anything to do with the ten kings or the ten toes of Daniel 2nd chapter?

ANSWER. -

As the ten kings illustrated by the ten toes of the Gentile image, and also the ten horns of the beast of Rev. 17: 12 to 14, represent the very last end of this Gentile age, when they are destroyed, as the Common Market is also a last day set up, they have a vital connection. Especially so in view of Rev. 13: 16, 17, where people will not be permitted to buy or sell unless they have the "Mark of the Beast", and worship the beast and his image.

QUESTION. —

I am confused about the beasts of Rev. 13, and 17 chapters. Are they the same? What became of the three also mentioned in the 13th chapter, the lion, the bear and the leopard?

ANSWER. -

THE KING JAMES TRANSLA-OF THE BIBLE TION

By THE EDITOR

The Lord speaks of a time in these last days when men shall speak perverse things to draw away disciples after themselves. We are in the closing time, when this prophecy must be fulfilled the same as all others.

Origin of the King James Version

The King James translation of the Scriptures was made under the reign of King James of England, who was successor to Queen Elizabeth whose reign over England is of the most happy memory. During the reign of Queen Elizabeth and prior to that time, the Scriptures consisted of translations endorsed by the Roman Catholic Church, and the reasons set forth for having a translation unbiased in every respect and untouched with popery or personal opinions were many.

King James summoned fifty men to do the work of translating the Bible from the original Greek text to the English language. The Grecian Empire being the world kingdom ruling just before the Empire of Rome, the Greek and the Latin languages were the two prevailing tongues of that time, and when the gospe went forth "To the Jew first, and also to the Greek" (Rom. 1: 16), there were many thou sands of people speaking the Greek language who accepted the gospel. Consequently the early writings of the apostles were immediate ly written in the Greek language, which manu scripts remained and were gathered together from various sources, there being eleven origina manuscripts in existence containing all or par of the New Testament.

The fifty men summoned by King James fo the important work of translating the Holy Scriptures into the English language were se lected from every religious sect known at tha time, and also from Greek and English profes sors who held to no religion. There were out standing Greek and English scholars from th following churches: / Lutheran, & Episcopal, 3, Ca tholic, 4Ani-Baptists, 5Church of God, 4 and Jews zand college professors not particularly intereste in any certain religion, and from ex-educator and statesmen.

These men were summoned with the ster decree that in case any of them wrongly trans lated the Greek according to his liking into English he would lose his head. There were bu forty-seven men out of the fifty who appeare and carried on the work which required three

years to complete.

The King James translation of the Bible therefore far the best of any translation we not have. It came about under circumstances whic prevented anything spurious entering our B ble, and is the best and purest version of th original Greek text known today. Dr. Martin Luther, founder of Protestant Churches said. "They — allege the Sabbath changed into Sunday — contrary to the decalogue as it appears, neither is there any example more boasted of than the changing of the Sabbath day. Great, say they, is the power and authority of the Church since it dispensed with one of the Ten Commandments." Augsburg Confession of Faith, Art. 28, pr. 9.

The first day of the week is mentioned eight times in the New Testament, but none of these made Sunday a day of rest and holy convocation (Matt. 28: 1; Mark 16: 2; Mark 16: 9; Luke 24: 1; John 20: 1; John 20: 19; 1 Cor. 16: 2: Acts 20: 7). No Scripture commands the observance of Sunday.

"By the very act of changing the Sabbath into Sunday which Protestants allow of, and therefore they fondly contradict themeslves by

keeping Sunday strictly".

-A Catholic Priest, James Cardinal Gibbons wrote: "You may read the Bible from Genesis to Revelation and you will not find a single line authorising the sanctification of Sunday. The Scriptures enforce the religious observance of Saturday, a day which we Catholics never sanctify".

The Faith of our Fathers (1917 ed.), pp. 72, Another Catholic Priest, T. Enright wrote: "The Bible says, "Remember that thou keep holy the Sabbath day", the Catholic Church say, 'Nol by my divine power, I abolish the Sabbath day and command you to keep holy the first day of the week'. — An American Sentinel, p. 173. -

The "Catholic Mirrow" dated September 23, 1893 read: "The Catholic Church for over one thousand years before the existence of a Protestant... changed the day from Saturday to Sunday".

Our forefathers, during the Dark Ages, had abolished one of the Ten Commandments. But now, since we are chanced to read the Bible, I plainly exhort that you help to restore Sabbath on the 7th day where God's prophets kept it.

Sabbath is for you and for me (Isaiah 56: 6-7. 66:23: Mark 2: 27; Ezekiel 20: 20;

THE SELF-LIFE HAS A TOUCHY DISPOSITION

It cannot bear to be rebuked or corrected. The strongest mark of genuine humility — is the ability to be reproved, corrected, even severely, with a meek and thoughtful spirit.

The following are some of the manifestations of the self-life.

The first thing that we notice is that the self-life has a disposition to look at everything with an eye as to how it will affect self. Instinctively it is forever "looking out for Number one".

If self preaches or prays or sings or gives money or time to God's work, it has a keen faculty for seeing how the results will affect its own honor or happiness.

In the second place, self is always unwittingly magnifying itself. It talks incessantly of its doings and great achievements. It relates incidents in its past life in such a way as to show off self to the best advantage.

It never admits of a humiliation or defeat; it seems never to see its own faults, but always speaks of its victories, and always makes the other person suffer defeat and disgrace.

In every emergency it represents self as coming off with flying colors. It is full of self-righteousness; it denies that it ever has any backsliding.

In fact it insists on being the beautiful hero in every circumstance and all this is done in the most artless and unwiting manner, until everybody, except the self-constitued hero, can see that it is bragging on itself.

This boasting can be mixed in the religion and preaching and table and parlor conversation in the most offensive degree, without the person's suspecting it.

And then, the self-life has a touchy disposition. This trait is especially mentioned by John Wesley. Touchiness is like wearing all the nerves of the body on the skin; it always seems to be on the alert to take slights and offenses at the least occasion.

If it is not bowed to and spoken to on every occasion, if it is not honored where it fancies it ought to be, it takes on spells and goes into vexatious thoughts and words.

A soul that is perfectly crucified, really loves to be little and lowly, and to move along quietly in a sweet, prayerful, unostentatious manner, without drawing attention to itself.

And when really filled with the mind of Jesus, it prefers to be ignored, that it may keep more perfectly detached from all things and persons and live shut in with God.

It is amazing how many there are who profess to be dead to self, and yet manifest a terrific sensitiveness of being slighted.

If they are not invited to preach or lead the prayer or sing, or do something in church work or religious gatherings — if their talents are not recognized — it is often quite difficult for them to conceal their ugly thoughts and feelings, and they will insist that their wretched touchiness is a part of the Christ-life.

Another horrible feature of touchiness is that it can never bear to be rebuked or corrected. The strongest mark of genuine humility is the ability to be reproved, corrected, even severely, with a meek and thoughtful

But where self is alive, there is self-defense at the slightest reproof. How can one be dead to self and alive to God when his feelings are hurt at offense real or imaginary? Again, the self-life puts forth an extra effort to impress people with its grace or gifts of the Spirit and power. Self is bent on making an extraordinary impression, and so gets the notion it must make demonstrations, or do something out of the way to impress people and draw attention to itself.

The very thought that one must do something extraordinary in religious demonstration is of the flesh! There is a religious and spiritual self that must be slain as well as a carnal self. — Selected.

RECORD YEAR SEEN FOR DIAMOND SALES DESPITE WAR SLUMP

There could hardly be a greater contrast than that between the big trading of the Ramat-Gan Diamond Bourse in October 1973 and six months later. During the October War the trading room contained only ghostlike memories, devoid as it was then, of its usual activity. Today it is again a beehive of busy buyers and sellers engaged in furious bargaining.

The short, but serious, crisis which hit the Israel diamond industry only a few months ago has already been almost forgotten. Future observers, when examining the astonishing annual figures of Israel's diamond exports, will probably discern nothing of the severe setback that our major export industry suffered in the autumn of 1973. They will record that in its early beginnings, soon after the State gained its independence, the annual export of diamonds averaged between 10 an 15 million dollars, increasing with leaps and bounds to reach the 56 million dollar mark in 1960.

Expansion did not slow down, but continued at an accelerated pace to reach about three times the 1960 figure only seven years later, in 1967, when Israel sold \$165 million worth of diamonds to foreign countries. Although many experts then predicted a decline in expansion, it took only six years more to triple the 1967 figure

In 1973 Israel's diamond exports reached the stupendous figure of \$557 milion. The year 1974 promises an even higher turnover than the record one reached a year

TEACHER TRAINING FOR IMMIGRANTS

HAIFA.— One hundred recent immigrants this week started courses in teacher training for future employment as teachers of physics, chemistry, mathematics, music and nutrition.

The courses, which will last up to two years, starting with Hebrew studies, were organized by the Absorption Ministry in cooperation with the Ministries of Education and Labour.

HIGHER ALIYA BUDGET SET FOR THIS YEAR

TEL AVIV. — This year's budget of the Jewish Agency's Immigration Department has been set at almost IL. 55 m. — an increase of some IL. 10 m. over last year's figure. In submitting estimates to the Agency's budgeting commission this week, Rabbi Mordechai Kirshblum, cochairman of the Immigration Department, said 13,500 immigrants are expected from western countries this year, a slight increase over last year's 11,800.

ISRAEL READY FOR "CREDIBLE COMPROMISE"

Israel will be prepared "to take any reasonable risk" and "make every credible compromise" to arrive at a genuine and secure peace with its Arab neighbours, Prime Minister Golda Meir said last night.

In an Independence Day message to World Jewry,

Mrs. Meir said Israel "will never bow to aggression, capitulate to unreasonable demands or compromise its vital security needs".

SPOT CHECK FOR ARMS

Police are making spot checks of vehicles, in a search for illegal possession of weapons. Two Haifa residents were arrested on Saturday night for possession of two Kalachnikov rifles, belonging to the Israel Defence Forces.

NO PORK FOR SAFAD

SAFAD. — A by-law banning pork in restaurants will now be enforced in Safad within a fortnight, Mayor Aharon Nahmias announced on Friday. "It is unthinkable that pork should be served in the town of the Kabbala", he said.

NEW CEMENT PLANTS GOING UP BELATEDLY

Before Israel's long-awaited third cement factory starts producing at Beit Shemesh (in June), a fourth and fifth plant are being planned — designed to bring output up to 3.5 m. tons a year by 1980 official sources say.

But the new enterprises are late in getting into swing. This year production will not exceed 2 m. tons, owing to slowdowns during the aftermath of the war. Another 200,000 tons has therefore to be imported, at \$50-60 a ton.

MASS GRAVE DISCOVERED — SEVENTY SYRIAN JEWS SAID MURDERED

A mass grave of 70 murdered Syrian Jews has been discovered, according to a recent report in "Le Figaro". A correspondent of the Paris newspaper said rumours circulating at Damascus University pin the blame for the murders on a Jew, who was "helping the 70 to escape, but then killed them for their money".

In Tel Aviv, Moshe Barnea, head of the Committee to Rescue Syrian Jewry, said that other reports, usually from French sources of the murder of Jews trying to flee Syria had invariably turned out to be true. He said the report was similar to the story of the four Syrian Jewish women, murdered when they tried to escape last March. —

The committee plans to step-up protests against the reaction of Dr. Henry Kissinger to the plight of Syrian Jewry, Mr. Barnea said. The committee members are incensed by his reference to the Syrian version of the girls' brutal death that the "four murderers are being brought to trial".

The Secretary of State is unlikely to be ignorant of the facts the committee claims, "namely, that the four sa-called murderers include two Jews, one of whom hap pens to be a cousin of one of the murdered girls, 182 year-old Eva Saad.

The Syrian authorities spread at least four different ersions of the story in their attempt to shrug off responibility for the crime.

According to the committee, the girls — three sisters f the same family aged 22, 23, and 24, and Eva Saad - were attempting to escape from Damascus via Beirut. They were deliberately led to a Syrian As-Sa'eka terrorist amp near the village of Meydaya, where they were aped and tortured before being put to death.

They are known to have left their Damascus homes on 'ebruary 28. Their bodies were "found" in a street of he Damascus ghetto on March 1. This fact clearly points to Syrian Government involvement, since they ould not have been brought to Damascus without the Syrian authorities being aware of it.

The Syrians refuse to let the 4,500-member Jewish community out. The Jews continue to be confined in shetoes and are subject to constant abuse, violence and

error. They are denied all civil rights.

Some 3,000 Jews live in the Damascus ghetto, 1,000 in sleppo and the remainder in the township of Khamushi. The Syrian Jewish community numbered 15,000 in 1947. Most of them left during the 1940s, especially after the 1947 pogroms in Aleppo.

NATIONAL GEOGRAPHIC DISTORTS TRUTH ABOUT SYRIAN JEWS

Sir, - How ironic it is that while Syria continues to oursue a policy of deliberate persecution against its Jewsh citizens, supposedly respectable publications throughout the world are printing articles which portray a completely erroneous picture of true conditions there.

I refer in particular to the March 18 article in "Der Spiegel" described by I. Sipper (April 26), and a simlar example of irresponsible journalism which appeared n the April 1947 edition of the "National Geographic Magazine", published in Washington, D.C. by the Naional Geographic Society, a purported educational organization ...

In a feature article entitled "Damascus, Syria's uneasy Eden", author Robert Azzi contends that "Damascus still 'tolerantly" embraces significant numbers of Jews", and hat today in Damascus Sephardic Jews "have rights like any other citizen... Syrian Jews have freedom of wor-

ship and freedom of opportunity."

Admitting that Jews are not free to emigrate, he none he less states that "reprisals against the families of those who leave, however are 'rare'." He then goes on to quote he Grand Mufti of Damascus: "We, as Moslems, know our religion demands that we treat others as we treat our own. This is basic".

When I wrote to the magazine to vigorously protest against their dissemination of such misleading information and to request that they print the true facts. I received the following begrudging admission from the chief

of the Research Staff.

"In the light of what you and other readers write, however, I think it is possible that we did indeed fail to show how difficult the situation of the Jews is in Syria. But if we failed, it was not because of bias or for lack of trying to get the true story. The entire article was reviewed by a number of experts on the area, including the 'Syrian' Desk officer at the State Department pere. Their comments confirmed the reporting of the author'.

the thousands of subscribers who read their damaging article. We agree with Justice Haim Cohen that there is a critical need for a public outcry at this time. Aroused public opinion is the only hope for Syrian Jewry. Therefore it is urgent that the public be made fully aware of the serious plight of the Jewish community in Syria, and that Syria receive the most strenuous condemnation by the world community.

Pressure must be brought to bear to force National Geographic to print the facts as they exist. We therefore urge every responsible, concerned citizen to write to National Geographic Magazine, 17th and M Streets, N.W., Washington, D.C., 20036, protesting against this article and demanding that they try a little harder to get, and then to print, the true story.
