Note. The Bible is an inspired book. Moses, to whom the Genesis is accredited, could not have given us that history, which was thousands of years before his birth, unless he was inspired by God. Note. Many present day preachers are trying to make the Sabbath Day a shadow that met its fulfillment, at the cross. They “err not knowing the Scriptures”. We observe that the Sabbath, the seventh day, antedates sin. When the Sabbath was made for man (Mark 2:27) the shadows were not in existence, for sin was not yet known. This being so, the seventh day Sabbath cannot be classed in the same category as the shadow Sabbath found in Lev. 23, and elsewhere. The Scriptures show this day to be a memorial of God’s creative work and not a shadow of anything to come.

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Lesson for June 19, 2021

FAITHFULNESS

Scripture Reading: Matthew 25.

Memory Verse: Matthew 25:45

1. What does the Lord say about requirements and qualifications for stewardship? 1 Corinthians 4:2.
2. Is the one who is faithful in that which is least also faithful in much? Luke 16:10.
3. Living, as we are, surrounded by commercialism where money becomes an absolute necessity for existence, how is the faithfulness of every individual tested? Luke 16:11.
4. What is especially said about faithfulness in that which is another man's referring to riches or money? Luke 16:12.
5. Is it possible for anyone to serve both God and mammon? Luke 16:13.

Note. The making of money for the express purpose of self glory and power is always promoted by the evil spirit of covetousness. Or when after the individual has sufficient of the world's goods to live the remainder of his life

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BAPTISM

Scripture reading: Romans 6

Memory verse: Romans 6:6

1. When the Ethiopian Eunuch asked to be baptized, how did Philip reply? Acts 8:37
2. What is the significance of Baptism? Romans 6:3, 4
3. Does the act of being buried in the water signify the washing away of sins, or does it signify the death of the old man? Romans 6:6; 1 Peter 3:21.
4. What hope is held out to those who are truly dead to sin? Romans 6:5-7
5. Should sin have any dominion over the baptized one? Rom. 3:7-12
6. Are they which degrade the body especially to be shunned? Rom. 6:12-16
7. What things must be put off? Col. 3:8, 9.
8. Should the new man have a natural hunger for spiritual things? Col.3:1-6
9. What things must be put on? Col. 3:10-15

Note. The ungrateful soul cannot rejoice; it is too full of self, of murmurings, to see the cause of joy. The late Alexander Whyte once visited an old woman who was full of murmurings. During a stay of 20 minutes he uttered not a word, but was patiently listening to her tale of woe. Then rising, he picked up his hat and gloves, and shaking her hand, said in farewell, "And mind ye forget not all His benefits!"

6. Does the Lord require a joyful people, ever rejoicing? Joel 2:23; Deut. 12:10-12; 16:11; 1 Chron. 16:10.

Note. If we dwell in the love of God, will we need to be exhorted to rejoice in the Lord? Do you feel that the believer who is always gloomy and despondent is failing in his obligation to God and man? Rejoicing in the Lord is mentioned 208 times in the Bible, and to be glad 37 times. Happiness in the Lord is also spoken of many times.

8. What did our Saviour do on Sabbath? Luke 4:16; Mark 1:21.
 9. What general command did God give us through a prophet, as to how we shall spend the Sabbath? Isa. 58, 13, 14.
 10. Besides attending religious meetings on the Sabbath, what is permissible? Matt. 12:10-13.
 11. What shall we do with our chores on the Sabbath day? Luke 13:15, 14:5.
 12. What does the Scriptures say concerning the right to work on the Sabbath? If thereby we can save our crops during harvest, should we see them spoiled otherwise? Ex. 34:21, 35:2.

- Note.** The Sabbath must be kept. No work or business of any kind is permissible. But we must do good on that day. He must be pulled out of the ditch, when he falls therein.

Note. There are many conflicting teachings in the different groups over the world. It matters not what any person might think or say. Our words must be according to His Word—the Written Word. Only then, there will be no contradiction. First comes Faith; then Virtue (His power—cleansing and purity).

Lesson for May 15, 2021
REQUIREMENT OF SALVATION.

Scripture reading: Matthew 3:1-17

Memory Verse: Romans 5:8

1. What all important questions was asked by the Philippian jailer? What was the answer? Acts 16:30-31

Note. The implication in the word “believe” are far reaching indeed. One who refuses to live according to the writings given by the Holy Spirit does not believe in Jesus Christ. The Holy Spirit of God calls for a transformation not a reformation.

2. On what other occasion was a similar question and answer used? Acts 2:36-38

Note. Here Peter places baptism on equality with repentance. Some today are advocating to no baptism at all. Are they lead by the Holy Spirit, or was Peter in error on the day of Pentecost? One who really believes in the teaching and the example Christ set will follow the Lord in Baptism.

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Lesson for April 24, 2021
**THE 4TH COMMANDMENT IN
THE
NEW TESTAMENT**

Scripture reading: Matthew 19:16-30.

Memory verse: Matthew 24:20.

1. When a man came to Jesus and inquired “What must I do?” What did Jesus reply? Matt. 19:16-19.

Note. Notice how Jesus emphasized the keeping of the Holy Commandments of God. Many who are seeking to justify themselves in not keeping the Sabbath say that Jesus mentioned the other commandments here, but made no mention of the Sabbath. They overlook the fact that the entire first four com-mandments were not mentioned here, and we all know that we cannot take the name of the Lord our God in vain, and be guiltless.

2. When Jesus spoke about the destruction of Jerusalem (which took place in 70 A.D.), did He ask His followers to keep the Sabbath of the Lord our God? Matt. 24:20.
3. What did Isaiah say that Jesus would do to the law? Isaiah 42:21.

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3. Before accepting Christ, in what must we first have faith and knowledge? John 5:39-47, Luke 24:25-27
4. What is true repentance? Eze. 18:29-32
5. How will the true repentance effect the thief? Eph. 4:28. The adulteress? John 8:11. The liar? Eph. 4:25. Idol Worship in any form? 1 John 5:21
6. With what message did John the Baptist and Jesus begin their public Ministry? Matt 3:1,2; 4:17
7. Who alone is responsible for our repentance? Rom. 2:4; 2 Tim. 2:25
8. Who made the first step to reconcile sinners to God? Rom:5:8
9. What was the sole purpose for which Christ suffered and died? 1 Peter 3:18
10. By whose righteousness are we to receive redemption? Rom. 3:22 -24.
11. What then is excluded from man? Rom: 3.27.

Note. By acceptance of Godliness through Christ all boasting is excluded. All that we accomplish comes by the grace of God. True Christians will not boast of their accomplishments.

Lesson for June 12, 2021
**THE CHRISTIAN DUTY OF
REJOICING**

Scripture reading: Psalms 97.

Memory verse: Phil. 4:4.

1. What admonition does the Psalmist give the righteous? Psa. 5:11; 32:11; 68:3.

Note. In the Word of God we find many references which exhort those who love and serve the Lord to be joyful and to express their joy in no uncertain manner.

2. Why should the Christian rejoice even when persecuted? Luke 6:23; Acts 5:41; 1 Peter 1:5-9.

Note. It was from a prison cell, when his future was uncer-tain, that the Apostle Paul enjoined his converts to “rejoice in the Lord always,” and then, as if he thought some would consider this a rash and impossible command, he convinced them by repeating, “And again I say, Rejoice!” Phil. 4:4.

3. What shall the reward of those who sow in tears? Psa. 126:5, 6.

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
