Lesson for April 30, 2022
WALKING AND ABOUNDING IN
RIGHTEOUSNESS

Scripture reading: Col. 3rd Chapter.

Memory verse: Col. 3:23.

1. After being received into the Heavenly family, for what should we always seek? Col. 3:1.
2. How should we consider the past, and how should we plan for the future? Verses 2 and 3.
3. What are some of the things we must put off? Verses 5-8.

9. What did Jesus say that the drink which was in the cup represented? Matthew 26:28; Luke 22:20. Compare with John 6:53, 54.

His own work in his own profession will be decidedly secondary in his life, and the “Kingdom Work” will come first and will be supported freely with a portion of his earnings, which represents a part of his life.

Note: The Gospels of Mark, Luke and John, tell us that the cup which Jesus blessed contained the fruit of the vine. This was the pure blood of the grape, which represents the precious Blood of Jesus. See Deuteronomy 32:14, last part.

Note: When this divine law of the Spirit is allowed to operate in us, we will by nature bear the fruit of the Spirit, and therefore walk in perfect obedience to all of the commandments. Consequently we will be free from the condemnation of this law, which brings death.

It fills us with goodness, and imparts to us those heavenly attributes that so miraculously adorned the
