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Lesson for October 25, 2025
THE DAUGHTER OF BABYLON

Scripture Reading: Rev. the 17th chapter.
Memory Verse: Last part of Verse 8. Same chapter.

1. Where is this daughter of Babylon first introduced?
Zechariah 2:7.
2. What was the purpose of the angel calling John to him, and what was the Message? Rev. 17:1.

Note: It is the JUDGEMENT of the women revealed in this chapter, and not her past. Therefore, it greatly concerns us today as we see world conditions in preparation for her judgment.

3. Before she goes to judgment will she have daughters? (Church Organizations), and, what of their character? Rev 17:5.
4. Will she become exalted in mind, because of her renewed popularity and position? Rev. 18:7.

Note: "This false apostate church was born and reared in Babylon, called the daughter of Babylon (Zech. 2:7), dressed up with Babylonish garments, adopted by Rome and named Christianity. The name now includes not only Catholicism, but fallen so-called

5. How is she to be carried to her judgment? Rev. 17:7
6. From what place does this beast come that carries her to judgment and whither is it bound? Verse 8, first- part.

Note: The phrase “Bottomless Pit” refers to a place unknown. The Roman head with the Papal horn introduced in Daniel the 7th chapter was wounded by the sword and then healed in the very last days, and comes back from the “Bottomless Pit”. or a place unknown. No. one ever found such a place. The deadly wound being healed and this beast coming back carrying the Papal Power, refers to the one and the same thing.

7. Who will be worshipping this Roman beast? Last part of Verse 8. Compare with Rev. 13:8, regarding the head that was wounded and then healed in the last time.
8. What does the Prophet Daniel tell us about this same head which carried the Papal Horn? How long was this horn or Papacy to persecute the Saints? Dan. 7:21, 22.

Note: We see here that the Papacy exists as a persecuting power right down to the time for the Saints to possess the Kingdom, which is yet future.

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Lesson for October 4, 2025 CREATION WEEK — LITERAL DAYS

2. How complete was this creation? John 1:3, Heb. 11:3.
3. What further leads us to know the days were literal? Gen. 1:5, 8, 13, 19, 23,31.
4. Was Christ with the Father at creation? Gen. 1:26; John 8:58 Col. 1:16-18.
5. What did Christ say of the length of the day? John 11:9.

Note. In these last days there are many teachers and self-styled preachers going around teaching many things contrary to the account of the creation given by God. One of the fallacies taught by many is that each day in the creation week was of much longer duration than the 24 hours which constitute the present day. That teaching is false; for a day in the creation was of the same duration as a day is in this age, and it will continue this way until the complete change takes place when the Holy City of God comes down, and then there will be no more night.

All who have died in the Lord will be made alive at the appearing of Jesus, while the living saints will be changed in a moment in the twinkling of an eye, and they will live and reign with Christ a thousand years. During this time Jesus will reign upon the throne of David. Luke 1:32; Isaiah 24:23.

Note: The holidays of Israel commemorate great miracles wherein heaven intervened and saved God's chosen people. "The Church or Family of God at that time". Surely it is no sin, but an act pleasing to the Creator for His people to remember, and not forget these outstanding miracles, viz; writing of the Ten Commandments on Mt. Sinai; Deliverance from Egypt., dwelling in booths and commemorating the "Feast of Tabernacles", also remembering and reading again the "Book of Esther", at the season when deliverance came to the chosen people.

Lesson for November 29, 2025 DO NOT BE ASHAMED TO BE A CHRISTIAN

NOTE: To be a follower of the most enlightened man of all ages, is nothing to be ashamed of. To be a fellow heir with the Son of the Creator of the universe is something to celebrate! While it is true that some may ridicule and persecute us for the sake of Christ, He tells us to "rejoice and be exceedingly glad" when this happens, "for great is your reward in Heaven."

6. After the Jews had gone through their bitter travail and brought forth, the new nation, what would the Remnant of His brethren do? Verse 3, last part.

Note: How wonderful it is to have lived at this time, and noted the past concerning the coming of our Messiah, and all of these events concerning Him being fulfilled, and now to see the Remnant all over the world returning to the Children of Israel. They are choosing Jerusalem, and not Rome. They are praying for Israel, and beginning to observe the holidays of this marvelous little Nation.

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Lesson for October 18, 2025 THE LAW OF THE SPIRIT UNLOCKS THE GOSPEL OF POWER

Scripture Reading: Luke 6: 17 to 40.

Memory Verse: Luke 6:19.

1. From what cities surrounding Palestine were the people gathered together? Luke 6:17.

Note: They had come from a distance of 150 miles and farther, which was a great effort in that time when walking was the main mode of travel.

2. What is said about all the sick in that great multitude? Verse 18.
3. In what way did the Saviour prepare himself for this great gathering? Verse 12.
4. After spending this night in prayer with what was his body charged, and filled to overflowing? Verse 19.
5. Was the Apostle Paul also possessed with this magnetic virtue so that people were healed? Acts 19:12,
6. These wonderful miracles are written for us, and what is the Command? I Cor. 11:1.
7. In order for us to perform all of these things today what becomes necessary? I Cor. 1:4 and 5.

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Note. It would be good for us, if we would study such Scriptures as 1 John 2:4-6, and 1 John 1:3-7, and also the 3rd chapter of 1 John. Now it is seen why it is life eternal to accept Jesus, for in Him dwells all the fullness of the God head. If we have Jesus in this manner, He possesses us and in us we have the fullness of heaven. Colossians 1:26, 27.

Lesson for November 15, 2025 THE LAMB OF GOD - MASTER AND LORD

Scripture Reading: John 1:29-41.
Memory Verse: John 13:13.

1. For what important purpose was Christ Jesus sent into the world? Mark 10:45.
2. Who alone was qualified as a substitute for every sinner? John 1:29.
3. What eternal truth did Jesus express in behalf of every child? Matthew 18:14.

When you tell anything that is not good about someone you are guilty of carrying a reproach, forbidden in the Bible. Psalms 15:1-3. When enriched by the Master, seeking for the Holy Spirit, and separating ourselves from evil talkers, and sinners, we can then be partakers of this divine nature, and be filled with Heavenly virtue

10. If someone literally strikes, you or even smites you with threats, or lies about you: should we do the same to them? Verses 29 to 31.-
11. In what way will the true servant, be different from the common people of the world? Verses 32 to 34.

Note. The Bible alone is to be our guide and rule in all that we teach. True Christians will be careful not to add anything to their belief which is not found to have been the teaching or practice of Jesus. Once this truth is established, our way becomes clear.
